1 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: Good morning. Let
2 the record reflect that Commissioner, Omar
3 Sabir, is participating in this morning's
4 meeting by telephone and we take this
5 opportunity to congratulate Commissioner Sabir
6 and his wife on the birth of their newborn
7 son.

8 And let's proceed. I call the April
9 20, 2022, meeting of the Philadelphia City
10 Commissioners to order.

11 First, I will preserve the order and
12 decorum of these meetings. Everyone in
13 attendance should be on notice that shouting
14 out or interrupting the proceedings will not
15 be tolerated. Those who violate this, will be
16 asked to leave.

17 The Sunshine Act permits anyone
18 attending a public meeting to object to a
19 perceived violation at anytime during the
20 meeting. If you choose to do so, please
21 succinctly state your objection. Objecting is
22 not an opportunity for speechmaking.

23 We will now move to public comment.
24 Commenters shall state where they live or if

1 they are not a resident of Philadelphia that
2 they are a Philadelphia taxpayer. Public
3 comment is not an opportunity for dialogue or
4 Q&A, it's public comment. A chance for you to
5 tell us what you think. Each speaker shall
6 have two minutes; however, I may extend this
7 time at my discretion. All public comments
8 must be relevant or germane to Board business.

9 Finally, it is my responsibility to
10 preserve the order and decorum of these
11 meetings. As such profane, slanderous,
12 discriminatory, or personal attacks will not
13 be tolerated.

14 Please note that we will be doing
15 polling place changes later in the meeting.
16 So anyone here wishing to be heard on polling
17 place changes should wait until that time.

18 Is there anyone here for public
19 comment? Hearing none, we will now move to
20 Commissioner Bluestein for e-mailed public
21 comment.

22 COMMISSIONER BLUESTEIN: There were no
23 e-mailed public comments as of 9:45 a.m. this
24 morning.

1 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: Thank you,
2 Commissioner.

3 We will now proceed to Old Business and
4 I will call on Joe Lynch to read the report
5 from the executive director.

6 MR. LYNCH: Good morning,
7 Commissioners.

8 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: Good morning, Joe.

9 MR. LYNCH: Today's Sunshine report:
10 As of yesterday, we have processed all paper
11 ballot applications received through Wednesday
12 and all election ballot applications through
13 Saturday. Before the Holiday, we received
14 3,000 paper applications that had to be
15 opened, separated and time stamped. There was
16 approximately 1,900 left that need to be
17 processed and will be entered by the end of
18 business today.

19 We have approximately 78,202
20 vote-by-mail applications for the Primary,
21 which is 2,406 added from last week's total.
22 Of those applications processed so far 47,472
23 are paper applications and 30,730 are
24 electronic applications.

1 Voter registration: For the election
2 cycle to date we have processed 94,860
3 registration applications of which 7,500 were
4 paper.

5 All units except for Documents are
6 working primarily on mail in applications.
7 They are also processing and proofing
8 registration apps and what mail-in apps come
9 in.

10 Documents are emptying the old street
11 lists and preparing for the new ones that come
12 in.

13 The Election Board

14 Online training: 919 poll workers did
15 online training. 5,920 are confirmed poll
16 workers. Left messages: 559. 1,622
17 in-person people have been trained. 1,622
18 in-person trained for poll workers. Total
19 schedule for in-person training: 1,076 to
20 date. That's all I have, Commissioners.

21 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: Thank you, Joe.
22 Just for clarity for the record, we have
23 approved 78,202 vote-by-mail applications for
24 the Primary?

1 MR. LYNCH: Yes.

2 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: Thank you.

3 We will now move to new business. Is
4 there anyone here who would like to speak on
5 moving a polling place? Please come forward.
6 Good morning. Please state your name for the
7 record.

8 MS. MORRIS: Good morning. My name is
9 Denise Morris (ph) I am the judge of election
10 at the 44th Ward, 2nd Division. Now, I object
11 to moving to the Simpson-Fletcher House
12 because it is small and where we vote at in
13 there, you only could get two people in at a
14 time with the Board of Election people in
15 there. And people gonna be standing in line
16 they're not gonna wait to vote. Now at the
17 rec center you can get more than two people in
18 the building. And there's room people can
19 come in and vote.

20 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: Okay, thank you.
21 Anybody else here to speak on a polling place
22 change? Good morning.

23 MS. DENARD: Good morning. My name is
24 Sherry Denard (ph). I'm also with the 44th

1 Ward and basically the same thing that she was
2 just saying. I'm on that same team with her
3 because usually on Election day it rains, and
4 we do get a lot of senior people to come and
5 vote -- and nobody wants to come out in the
6 rain and stand in the rain if we can only let
7 two people in at a time. That's not a good
8 thing. So I feel as though we need to stay
9 where we are at the Conestoga place.

10 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: Thank you.

11 MS. DENARD: You're welcome.

12 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: Okay. We will now
13 proceed with Charlie Stroman with polling
14 place relocations. Charlie.

15 MR. STROMAN: Good morning,
16 Commissioners.

17 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: Good morning,
18 Charlie.

19 MR. STROMAN: As of right now we have
20 708 polling places for the May 17th Primary.
21 We are still waiting to confirm two places.
22 When we have them, it will be 100 percent
23 complete.

24 Now, moving to the hearings. In the

1 2nd Ward in the 4th Division we're asking to
2 go from Santore Library to Capitolo Rec Center
3 for voter convenience.

4 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: I motion that we
5 approve the proposed move 2nd Ward, 4th
6 Division.

7 COMMISSIONER BLUESTEIN: Second.

8 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: Commissioner
9 Bluestein, please call the roll.

10 COMMISSIONER BLUESTEIN: Commissioner
11 Deeley?

12 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: Aye.

13 COMMISSIONER BLUESTEIN: I vote aye.
14 Commissioner Sabir?

15 COMMISSIONER SABIR: Aye.

16 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: The polling place
17 change 2nd Ward, 4th Division has passed
18 unanimously.

20 in the 2nd Ward again in the 12th Division.
21 From Courtyard Apartments at Riverview to the
22 Santore Library for voter convenience.

23 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: I motion that we
24 approve the proposed move 2nd Ward, 12th

1 Division.

2 COMMISSIONER BLUESTEIN: Second.

3 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: Commissioner
4 Bluestein, please call the roll.

5 COMMISSIONER BLUESTEIN: Commissioner
6 Deeley?

7 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: Aye.

8 COMMISSIONER BLUESTEIN: I vote aye.

5 MR. STROMAN: There's a little bit of a
6 walk up the hill. And at Juniata Youth Club,
7 you can literally park right in front of the
8 door where you walk in. So the voters can
9 come literally right up to door and park and
10 walk right in whereas they would have to park
11 on the street and walk up the hill to the
12 Ferko Rec Center.

16 the Heston School to the Bibleway Baptist
17 Church, back to the original location.

17 COMMISSIONER BLUESTEIN: So Charlie for

18 44-19, your moving out of the Simpson-Fletcher

19 Senior Homes and the 44-2, which was held is

20 being proposed to move into it. How many

21 divisions can fit in that location?

22 MR. STROMAN: In the Simpson-Fletcher?

23 COMMISSIONER BLUESTEIN: Yeah.

24 MR. STROMAN: I would say two.

1 COMMISSIONER BLUESTEIN: How many are
2 there currently?

3 MR. STROMAN: There are two there now
4 from my recollection.

5 COMMISSIONER BLUESTEIN: So if there
