3 STAFF: I do.

4 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: Thank you.

5 Pursuant to the 1937 Pennsylvania Election  
6 Code, the canvas of the votes cast in the  
7 Primary and Special Election of Tuesday, May  
8 17, 2022, in the City and County of  
9 Philadelphia is now officially open.

10 Call 1st ward, 1st division.

11 MR. LYNCH: Before everybody leaves,  
12 can I just say this and I'm one of the most  
13 guilty of this but starting today there's no  
14 more pulling up of the racks and cutting  
15 through, anything like that. If the people  
16 here have to use the bathroom, they have use  
17 to the bathroom in the corner over there.

18 So there's no more pulling up the gates  
19 and cutting through, all right? You have to  
20 walk all the way around. You'll get your  
21 steps in. Thank you.
