CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: Good morning. I
would like to call the meeting of
September 16, 2020, to order.

We will move to public comment. Before
we do so just like to state that commenters
shall state where they live or if they are not
a resident of Philadelphia, that they are a
Philadelphia taxpayer.

Public comment is not an opportunity
for dialogue or Q and A. It is public
comment. A chance for you to tell us what you
think. Each speaker shall have two minutes.
However I may extend this time at my
discretion. All public comments must be
relevant or germane toward business.

Finally, it is my responsibility to
preserve the order and decorum of the meetings
as such profane, slander, discriminatory or
personnel attacks will not be tolerated.

Anyone here about polling place
locations, that subject matter will be handled

1 later in the meeting.

2 Anyone wishing to offer public comment
3 at this time, please step forward.

4 MR. GARELLA: Good morning,
5 Commissioners.

6 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: Good morning.

7 MR. GARELLA: My name is Rich Garella.
8 I'm a Philadelphia voter.

9 THE PUBLIC: Louder.

10 MR. GARELLA: My name is -- is this on?
11 Hello. My name is Rich Garella. I am a
12 Philadelphia voter.

13 I wanted to touch on a couple of topics
14 very briefly. One is the transcripts issue.
15 Now that it is clear that you long have the
16 right to post transcripts for the public, we
17 urge you to start doing so. We also urge you
18 to post the minutes of each meeting that are
19 required by the Sunshine Act upon completion
20 after each meeting as well as ideally before
21 the meetings.

22 The second is publication of your plans
23 for polling locations. We've seen that signs
24 are posted at some polling locations that

1 you've proposed to change. This is at best
2 minimal compliance with the law. You have no
3 list of the locations and these should be on
4 your website to give the public the maximum
5 rather than the minimum notice in case they
6 have any questions. It's possible to maintain
7 a list which shows which locations are
8 proposed to change.

9 The third is that we urge you to take
10 advantage of the city's information technology
11 resources to help people hold these meetings
12 virtually. As the vast majority of the city's
13 boards and agencies are successfully doing to
14 make them as accessible to the public as
15 possible.

16 We continue to offer our
17 recommendations on how to get these meetings
18 as open as they can be. We've submitted those
19 documentations for the record. We've also
20 submitted today the text of two WHYH news
21 articles that are relevant to these topics for
22 the record of today's meeting. Thank you.

23 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: Anyone else for
24 public comment, please step forward.

1 MS. MIRIAM: Hello my name is Miriam
2 (ph) with Protect Our Vote Philly. I'm a
3 resident of Philadelphia and I would like to
4 suggest that you turn up your volumes so that
5 there is greater distance from the microphone.
6 This is an issue here, thank you.

7 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: Anyone in here for
8 in-person public comment not related to
9 polling places? Okay. We'll now move to a
10 report from our Secretary regarding emailed
11 public comment.

12 COMMISSIONER SABIR: Good morning. The
13 City Commissioner's office had received two
14 public comments that were forwarded to us
15 after 9:45 a.m. today. Those comments will be
16 read at the end of this meeting.

17 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: Thank you. We will
18 now proceed to old business with a report from
19 Executive Director Joe Lynch.

20 MR. LYNCH: Good morning,
21 Commissioners.

22 THE PUBLIC: Please increase the
23 volume. This is ridiculous. Put a microphone
24 that works.

1 MR. LYNCH: To date there are --

2 THE PUBLIC: -- we are listening to
3 people who are going to be using this
4 microphone.

5 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: Excuse me.

6 THE PUBIC: We are in a space --

7 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: -- Excuse me.

8 MR. LYNCH: Good morning,
9 Commissioners.

10 To date we have processed 267,778
11 absentee and mail-in applications that are
12 approved. For the absentee, there was 24,075,
13 1,222 paper, 22,853 were online.

14 For mail-in ballots, there was 240,812.
15 Out of that 93,449 were paper, 147,363 were
16 online.

17 Civilian overseas applications 724,
18 federal voter application, 1,836, military
19 applications, 331. Total ballots that were
20 approved overall was 263,416.

21 There's a total of 31,000 outstanding
22 ballot applications to date. For this cycle
23 to date for voter registration, we processed
24 151,089 registrations. Of that, 20,650 was

1 paper.

2 We are processing 3,800 paper
3 registrations from 09/14 and we're opening the
4 mail from 09/15. The electronic applications
5 are all up-to-date.

6 For polling places there's 1,703
7 divisions. 1,600 and 14 divisions are solved.
8 That's 94.8 percent and 1,680 sites are
9 confirmed to date. That's all I have,
10 Commissioners.

11 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: Thank you, Joe. We
12 will now hear a report from Charles Stroman
13 regarding new business and polling places.

14 MR. STROMAN: Good morning,
15 Commissioners. I would like to start with a
16 quick update from the divisions announcements.

17 Division 17 -- Ward 17, Division 12,
18 Ward 31, Division 17 and Ward 46, Division 8
19 are announced as remaining at the same polling
20 places they voted in the 2020 primary.

21 These divisions are going to change and
22 will come up at a future hearing.

23 Also 31/6 is now confirmed to remain at
24 Simons(ph) Rec Center moving forward.

1 As I stated this year, our goal is to
2 have as many divisions as possible to be able
3 to return to their regular polling places.
4 Meaning where they voted for their 2019
5 general election.

6 We would like to move the 472 divisions
7 listed on the sheets in front of you from
8 their consolidated locations back to their
9 locations where they voted in the 2019 general
10 election. A copy of the list has been given
11 to each Commissioner and is available at the
12 public comment table. I ask that the list be
13 moved into the record or if you'd like I can
14 read through all 472 changes.

15 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: I make a motion to
16 move the list into the record.

17 COMMISSIONER SCHMIDT: Second.

18 COMMISSIONER SABIR: I'm in favor.

19 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: In favor.

20 COMMISSIONER SCHMIDT: In favor.

21 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: So moved, Charlie.

identification.)

MR. STROMAN: Thank you. This week's
list is for wards 1 through 33. I will have a
similar list available next week for your
consideration for wards 34 through 66.
Notices were placed on the two 2020 primary
polling places to propose the 2020 general
elections and within the division.

If the changes are approved, we will
update the running list on
Philadelphiavotes.com and the sources for each
of the divisions.

I would ask that the polling places for
472 listed on the sheets in front of you be
approved.

CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: I vote to approve.
I'm sorry before we proceed, is there anybody
here for public comment about polling places?
So we are going to have to ask you to come up
in order.

1 I guess we'll take the back row first.
2 So anybody that's in the back if you want to
3 come up and then we'll get to the front. So
4 when you are coming up to comment on the
5 polling places I would just remind you that
6 you have two minutes, thank you. Please state
7 your name for the record also, thank you.

8 MS. STRAUSS: Good morning,
9 Commissioners. Thank you for having me here.
10 I did send an email with this because I wasn't
11 sure I was going to get here, but I do want to
12 say I'm Sharon Strauss. I'm a voter in 9/12
13 and a member of Vote Philly and Indivisible
14 Philly and I noticed the sign -- this lovely
15 sign right here when I was out walking the
16 other day around Lincoln Drive and Allens
17 Lane.

18 I want to thank you for posting the
19 information. However as of right now which
20 was at 9:30 this morning when I wrote this and
21 I presume it's still the case given the
22 comments from the last speaker, this proposed
23 polling place is not even listed on your
24 website.

1 In fact, the single polling place
2 listed for all of the ninth ward at this time
3 is mine, division 12 the one at the Lucien
4 (ph) Center.

5 Actually I'd rather vote at the Art
6 center, which is where division 14 is supposed
7 to vote since it's much closer to me, but
8 that's not the issue.

9 The issue is without knowing what other
10 divisions proposed for the Art Center, which
11 no one could know prior to coming to this and
12 even don't know now because you have not given
13 the public the opportunity and we only have
14 this list right here in front of me.

15 There is no way to know whether that
16 even makes any sense for division 14. The Art
17 Center isn't that big. In the fall, you have
18 a couple of divisions there and depending on
19 your plans for November this may or may not be
20 a viable option given the need for social
21 distancing.

22 I'm not going to comment on whether it
23 is because I don't know -- actually I can look
24 here quickly and see but I don't really know

1 the square footage of the art center offhand
2 so it doesn't make much difference.

3 Just posting a few signs at random
4 locations does not give voters enough
5 information to necessarily see at all -- like
6 if I haven't been walking at the corner of
7 Allens Lane and Lincoln Drive, I would never
8 had known that you're planning to move the
9 polling place and I don't know whether the
10 people who are the residents of division 14
11 know this.

12 So just posting the signs doesn't give
13 us enough information to even see the plan let
14 alone intelligently comment on the plan.

15 And this isn't related to the polling
16 place but I just wanted to take this moment
17 that I have to offer a question of what's
18 going on with the poller applications because
19 I understand we're still short on
20 applications.

21 I put in an application to offer my
22 help through Philadelphia Vote and I just
23 wondering when and how I can expect a response
24 and also --

1 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: -- your two minutes
2 is up and I would also let you know that 9/12
3 is staying where it was in the primary and it
4 is supposed to go on our website. It came up
5 last week as one of the locations that was not
6 moving.

7 MS. STRAUSS: Okay. Thank you.

8 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: Thank you, have a
9 good day. Next person from the back row
10 please. Good morning. Please state your name
11 for the record.

12 MR. GIBSON: Lawrence Isaac Gibson.
13 I'm the Judge of Elections for the 22 ward, 26
14 division. I'm here today because I'm
15 absolutely disgusted with how this process is
16 going.

17 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: You have to put
18 your mask on if you are going to use the
19 microphone because other people are going to
20 use the microphone.

21 MR. GIBSON: I understand. I'm here
22 today because I'm absolutely disgusted with
23 how this process is going. I normally come
24 here with understanding and reason and this is

1 disgusting. There's no notification, no
2 proper --

3 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: -- excuse me, sir.
4 I'll ask you just kindly to lower your voice,
5 thank you.

6 MR. GIBSON: I would kindly ask that
7 you help advertise the change of the polling
8 locations. That's why I'm here today.
9 There's one poster at the 22 ward, 26 division
10 at the corner of Crittenden and Gravers
11 Street. There is not enough notice.

12 There is not one poster for that entire
13 division. I have over 500 voters I have to
14 consider. I did get a -- I wrote a letter to
15 the entire Board of -- I'm sorry I'm very
16 flustered. I did write a letter to the entire
17 City's Commissioners office, to all three
18 members explaining my concerns about all this.
19 The lack of notification and the lack of
20 signage. Along with lack of notification
21 made. The Judge of Elections of my division
22 and the change of this polling place.

23 I find this disgusting and I find this
24 absolutely repugnant and I am very upset that

1 I have to go around and tell all my neighbors
2 personally about this meeting because there's
3 not proper notification about this meeting.

4 In terms of changing the polling place
5 itself, I have to say I am not completely
6 opposed to it. It's close to my house and
7 it's close to all my neighbors. I have to
8 react that the person who owns this polling
9 place ran for Congress two years ago but that
10 was two years ago and that's not now.

11 With the lack of transparency though is
12 the fact that I have to go three and a half
13 miles from my house to talk about this issue
14 instead of going online or going on a phone
15 call. It is disgusting and it is repugnant
16 and I already know that these changes about
17 the polling places are not going up until a
18 week before the election and that's voter
19 suppression.

20 The fact that people are going to go to
21 the wrong place expecting their voting place
22 to be there and will be moved beforehand and
23 they will only have maybe a week's notice is
24 disgusting.

1 I try to be more elegant when I speak
2 publicly but I really am upset about this and
3 I -- if nothing else, I also understand there
4 is a lot going on with this pandemic and I
5 understand you have a lot on your plates.

6 If I have only one thing I can add to
7 this one request I would make other than
8 making these meetings online again. Other
9 than that I would say after you make these
10 changes to the polling places, please send out
11 the postcards as soon as possible. Not a week
12 before the election we cannot have that this
13 time. Thank you.

14 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: Thank you very much
15 and just 22/25 and 22/26, they will be brought
16 up at another time. They're not on the agenda
17 today.

18 Next speaker from the back. We're
19 going to go from the back forward because of
20 the need to social distance. So anyone else?
21 Who's still here to speak on -- come forward,
22 ma'am. Good morning. Please state your name
23 for the record.

24 MS. WEISS: Good morning. My name's

1 Paula Weiss and I'm a committee person in
2 2207. Just to reiterate what other people
3 have said about the notice given. A neighbor
4 alerted me to the poster, otherwise I wouldn't
5 have seen it. There is one in my division as
6 far as the hearing today. But I'm here to
7 actually propose an alternative location to
8 the move back to your original location. So
9 in 2207 our original polling place is Jesus Is
10 The Way Church, which is a very small
11 storefront church.

12 It is actually outside of our division
13 across from Germantown Avenue which is
14 cobblestone. It does not have a crosswalk.
15 We have two large apartment buildings on our
16 street. A lot of our voters (inaudible) they
17 are elderly, they (inaudible).

18 And so I've done a little bit of
19 research and I've found an alternative
20 location to become our polling place. They
21 have ADA-complaint entrance, they are looking
22 to do more community service as a nonprofit
23 organization and I'd like to thank Mr. Stroman
24 for helping to work with us and make that

1 possible.

2 But we really need to franchise more
3 voters in our division. We had arranged for
4 rides for them previously and had a good
5 volunteer network but we can't do that now due
6 to the pandemic so we're asking for your help,
7 the Commissioners office to help us get the
8 polling places changed.

9 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: Commissioners, I
10 ask that we take this proposal under
11 advisement and ask our polling place
12 supervisor Charles Stroman to please do an
13 investigation.

14 COMMISSIONER SCHMIDT: I agree.

15 COMMISSIONER SABIR: I agree.

16 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: Thank you very
17 much, ma'am. We will check it out. Who else
18 is here for public comment regarding the
19 polling places? Come forward sir.

20 MR. MARK: I'm Mark. I'm the librarian
21 at the Nicetown-Tioga library. If I may, I'd
22 like to ask a question. So this is a City
23 Election Commission Meeting? Is that right?
24 Yes, okay. So this morning I walk in and I

1 see a notice that the 2020 primary polling
2 place for 13/23 will be moved from (inaudible)
3 to Nicetown. So how does this work? Does the
4 library get notified or this was kind of a
5 shock to us. Anybody?

6 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: Charles?

7 MR. STROMAN: So it was at Nicetown in
8 2019. We're just putting it back to the same
9 place.

10 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: So that polling
11 location in the past had been at the library.
12 We moved it in June because of the
13 consolidation. So we're simply moving it back
14 to its original location.

15 MR. MARK: Can I ask why? We are not
16 open to the public, we don't have staff. So
17 are you going to make this a public place by
18 November 3rd is that the idea?

19 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: Thank you. We'll
20 take that under advisement and then -- I mean
21 that's the primary's -- we've already been in
22 consultation with the library.

23 Anybody else here to speak on public
24 comment in regard to the polling places? I'm

1 sorry sir. This gentleman first and then you
2 can come up, sir, with the hat on you can come
3 up. Thank you.

4 MR. STAFFORD: Good morning. I'm here
5 representing 2036 East Hanes Street.

6 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: Thank you, sir.
7 Can you state your name for the record please.

8 MR. STAFFORD: Joseph Stafford. I
9 represent two locations, 2036 East Hanes
10 Street and 4050-17 West Poplar Street. The
11 question was coming in if there was a change
12 in location, which they didn't quite
13 understand what they saw on the poster
14 outside. I'm here to tell you that the place
15 is available for those two addresses and
16 locations.

17 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: Do you know the
18 ward and division sir by any change?

19 MR. STAFFORD: Unfortunately I don't.

20 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: What's the address.

21 MR. STAFFORD: 2036 East Hanes street.

22 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: 2036 East Hanes
23 Street.

24 MR. STAFFORD: And 4050-17 West Poplar

1 Street.

2 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: We are going to
3 take some time to determine what ward and
4 division they are and get back to you. Sir,
5 those two addresses are not coming up on our
6 list so I'm going to ask that you give your
7 information to Mr. Stroman and we will follow
8 up with you, okay?

9 MR. STAFFORD: Thank you.

10 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: Thank you, sir.
11 The gentleman with the red shirt.

12 MR. MCCLENNEN: Good morning. My name
13 is Gorge McClennen (ph) and my wife Karen is
14 with me and we're here because on telephone
15 polls in our neighborhood was a notice for
16 this meeting to come and discuss our polling
17 place, which was closed and consolidated to
18 Sole High School so I think it's 21st ward 4th
19 division. Previously used to be at Houston
20 playground in Roxborough and so the notice on
21 the poll was if you're interested in having
22 Houston playground reopened as a polling spot
23 for November 3rd to come to this meeting, so
24 we did. And we will also be willing to

1 volunteer if that site needed workers so
2 that's our story.

3 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: Thank you so much.
4 We'll get your information and thank you.
5 Thanks for coming out and being part of the
6 process. Anybody else here to speak about a
7 polling place? Do you have business with the
8 ward, ma'am?

9 THE PUBLIC: Yes I do. I'm from 28/16
10 ward division and we were at the library, we
11 have a few polling places there and we were at
12 that spot this year. It was so chaotic, there
13 was too much going on, people didn't want to
14 go to other people table, they didn't know
15 where to go.

16 So my question is are we going to have
17 our same people back at our same polling place
18 where people know where they be going.

19 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: So the comments now
20 are for polling place locations. We are
21 approving polling place locations in phases.
22 June, as you said, were consolidated. There
23 was no consolidation plan for the November
24 election.

1 THE PUBLIC: So all the people that
2 come to (inaudible) change to make same spot
3 not in June but prior.

4 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: I don't know your
5 ward and division.

6 THE PUBLIC: 28/16. 13,14,15, and 16.

7 COMMISSIONER SCHMIDT: Widener Branch
8 Library?

9 THE PUBLIC: That is correct.

10 COMMISSIONER SCHMIDT: That's where
11 it's going back to.

12 THE PUBLIC: 13, 14, 15, and 16. So
13 that is good. Thank you.

14 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: Thanks for coming
15 down and being a part of the process.

16 Anybody else here for public comment
17 about the polling locations?

18 So now I'm going to make a motion that
19 we approve everything on the list to be
20 approved that Mr. Stroman submitted and we
21 will take under advisement and withhold 2207
22 and 1323. Do I have a second.

23 COMMISSIONER SCHMIDT: Second.

24 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: All in favor?
