These offices will be crucial to provide an alternative option for the votes of Philadelphia.

At these satellite offices a voter can go to a location and register to vote if needed. Request a mail-in ballot in person, receive it, vote and return it. All at the same location.

In addition voters can bring already voted ballots, making the satellite offices also drop off locations. Staffing is key to everything that (inaudible) especially for this year's general election. To both, prepare for and educate voters.

By the standards of other departments we are not (inaudible). Despite this, we are taking on a tremendous burden to meet the expectations that the voters have of us.

Expectations that we understand are paramount to democracy and deserve to be met.

When I first made my press release regarding the satellite offices last Friday, I thought the staffing would be fully available to open all 17 locations on Tuesday the 29th

of September. The last few days showed that would not be the case.

2.

We have made the assessment that we will not have enough trained people to open all 17 offices on September 29th. Rather than roll the dice and have significant errors and mistakes, I would like to propose that we do a rolling opening of satellite offices.

We will open seven of the originally proposed locations on the 29th of September and then the remaining 10 locations as the staffing becomes available.

This reflects the reality of what we are able to do right now with current data and facts. It does not reflect the ideal voting experience that we would like to achieve.

Furthermore, I will propose that these offices hold off on issuing replacement ballots to those voters who have already requested absentee or mail-in ballots until October 6th in order to avoid a rush of people whose ballots are already in the mail from descending on offices causing lines for those who have yet to apply.

The pandemic has only 16 exacerbated those problems. 17 The grant from CTCL has helped us deal with some of the pandemic costs but the 18 19 structural problems with our budget mainly. 20 As we approach the home stretch for 21 Election Day it will be imperative upon the administration to provide the resources and 22 23 the staff needed for this election to be 24 successful.

A watchdog group is shaming the Philadelphia City Commissioners for no longer livestreaming meetings and holding them in an obscure, out-of-the-way location.

The commissioners, who run elections in the city, say they're following state transparency laws, but an expert on those laws says despite that, their recent actions are "disturbing."

The conflict between the group, Protect Our Vote Philly, and the commissioners dates back more than a year. It came to a head after the commissioners' most recent public meeting, at which they announced a major grant from a nonprofit that would help pay for improvements for the 2020 election. They would include pandemic hazard pay for poll workers, setting up neighborhood election offices where voters could drop off mail-in ballots, and offering more secure ballot drop-off boxes.

to make things easier for voters," he wrote.

POV Philly keeps a frequently-updated document detailing what it sees as the commissioners' violations of, or "minimal" compliance with, Pennsylvania's Sunshine Act, which requires government agencies to conduct their deliberations publicly.

It includes more than a year of actions they find troubling, and eight other groups have cosigned it.

Melissa Melewsky, an attorney with the Pennsylvania NewsMedia Association who specializes in public records and transparency issues, said while none of the commissioners' transparency decisions seem obviously illegal, they're "far from ideal" and "not sufficient."

For instance, she said, not releasing meeting minutes seems counterintuitive.

The minutes are public record, and any member of the media or public should be able to file a Right-To-Know request to obtain them. The commonwealth's Office of Open Records recommends government agencies post their minutes online as a matter of course.

She added, there's also no reason the commissioners can't figure out a way to livestream their in-person meetings so people who can't get to the warehouse in person — a significant barrier, due to its location and the threat of COVID-19 — have a way to see what's going on.

"This is a point in time where we have agencies clamoring to offer alternative methods of access, and here we have an agency that's doing less," she said. "That's unusual and problematic."

After an apparent misunderstanding of their contract with a stenography company, the Philadelphia City Commissioners say they may begin releasing transcripts of their public meetings.

The commissioners, who oversee elections in the city, pay a stenographer to write down what happens at their meetings. But those transcripts don't become public, nor do the commissioners release meeting minutes.

Asked why, Deputy Commissioner Nick Custodio first said that "per the City's contract with the stenography company, copies of transcripts must be obtained directly from them."

Pressed on what exactly the contract required, and why the commissioners couldn't release abbreviated minutes after their meetings, as many state and city departments do, Custodio changed course.

The transcription contract that covers the commissioners and the city's other departments, he said, actually "explicitly" allows transcripts to be provided on city websites.

"In her first year, Commissioner [Lisa] Deeley tried to put the transcripts on the website, but the Chairman's office, at the time, gave her that explanation [that the contract forbade republishing]," he said in an email. "It hasn't been revisited since." Deeley began serving as a commissioner in 2016.

For his part, Garella said he's concerned about meeting transcripts because he wants to make sure Philadelphians know how their elections are being conducted — particularly as the city prepares for an unprecedented general election to be conducted during a pandemic, when far more people will vote by mail and the postal service is experiencing significant delays.

"The rules are changing," he said. "This is a time when the Board of Elections really needs to have public input, and when the public really needs to understand and trust what the Board of Elections is doing."


