4 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: Good

5 morning. I call the meeting of

6 October 28, 2020 to order. We

7 will begin with public comment.

8 Commenter's shall state where they

9 live, or if they are not a

10 resident of Philadelphia, but they

11 are a Philadelphia taxpayer.

12 Public comment is not an

13 opportunity for dialogue or Q and

14 A. It is public comment. A

15 chance for you to tell us what you

16 think. Each speaker shall have

17 two minutes, however, I may extend

18 this time at my discretion. All

19 public comment must be relevant or

20 germane to Board business.

21 Finally, it is my

22 responsibility to observe the

23 order and decorum of the meetings

24 as such, profane, slanderous,

1 discriminatory, or personal
2 attacks will not be tolerated.

3 Anyone wishing to offer
4 public comment, please step
5 forward.

6 MR. GARELLA: Good morning,
7 Commissioners. My name is Rich
8 Garella and I'm a voter in
9 Philadelphia. I'm with Protect
10 Our Vote Philly, as you know.

11 First, I just want to thank
12 all you for your hard work and I
13 want to recognize especially the
14 staff of the Commissioner's office
15 who have clearly been going above
16 and beyond taking on an enormous
17 challenge, and it's almost
18 unimaginable what you folks have
19 been going through.

20 I want to mention one thing
21 that I hope very much will be
22 addressed today, which is the
23 procedures and rules for public
24 observation and for party and

1 candidate representatives during
2 the canvass and pre canvass. The
3 last couple of years we have had
4 to go to election court to force
5 this Board to make any kind of
6 proceedings letting the public and
7 the party representatives know how
8 to do their job and carry out
9 their rights under the election
10 code. We know that you folks and
11 the staff have a huge amount of
12 work coming up just before
13 election day and on election day
14 and all of the days around it. So
15 we hope you will just handle that
16 and get some good, clear
17 proceedings out beforehand this
18 time. We really hope you do.

19 The last thing I just,
20 again, want to thank all of you
21 for the hard work you've done, all
22 the staff for the hard work. I
23 want to thank you for the
24 improvements that we have seen,

1 and I want to say that I think
2 that our group, Protect Our Vote
3 Philly, certainly and all the
4 people of Philadelphia are united
5 with you in our wish that this
6 election goes as smoothly as it
7 possibly can, and that every
8 single vote in Philadelphia cast
9 by a Philadelphian is counted
10 accurately, efficiently, and
11 smoothly and quickly.

12 Thank you.

13 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: Thank
14 you.

15 Anyone else for public
16 comment?

17 (No Response.)

18 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: Hearing
19 none. We will move to a report
20 from the Secretary.

21 COMMISSIONER SABIR: Good
22 morning. The Commissioner's
23 office are in receipt of all
24 public comment e-mailed to our

1 office by 9:45 today. These
2 comments were shared with each
3 Commissioner and Deputy at 10 a.m.
4 today. There's comments are also
5 provided to each Commissioner at
6 the beginning of this meeting and
7 are also available for public
8 review at the public comment
9 table.

10 We have received one public
11 comment by e-mail. The public
12 comment was received by Emma
13 Tramble. I have reviewed this
14 comment and ask that this comment
15 be moved into the record.

16 COMMISSIONER SCHMIDT: I've
17 also read the public comment
18 submitted and agree it should be
19 moved into the record.

20 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: I've
21 also read the public comment, and
22 agree it should be moved into the
23 record.

24 So moved.

1 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: We will
2 now proceed to old business with
3 the Executive Director report
4 which will be given by Nick
5 Custodio.

6 NICK CUSTODIO: Good
7 morning, Commissioner's.
8 Executive Director Joe Lynch is
9 busy preparing for the election,
10 so he asked me to give his report.

11 As of the this morning, the
12 Board has -- the staff has
13 approved 444,038 mail-in and
14 absentee ballots for the 2020
15 general election. They have about
16 300 -- I'm sorry 300 applications
17 outstanding and 89,070 were
18 approved yesterday on deadline
19 day.

20 Total online applications
21 not processed is about 200. All
22 online applications processed
23 through 10/26 was 2,101, paper
24 applications received on 10/27 was

1 100. Total paper applications
2 have to be processed is 100. The
3 Election Board Unit has 8,400
4 people trained to date, and with
5 1,300 people have been trained to
6 work the polls on election day.

7 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: Thank
8 you. We will now proceed with the
9 deputy report.

10 Deputy.

11 MR. CUSTODIO: Good morning,
12 Commissioner's. In the past week
13 we installed drop boxes at
14 Markwood Playground, Helbano Rec
15 (ph), Dorothy Emanuel Rec Center
16 (ph), Pleseant Playground, Ford
17 PAL, Smith Playground, Vogt Rec
18 Center, Independence Branch
19 Library.

20 We have continued to search
21 for locations elsewhere in
22 Philadelphia with videocamera
23 surveillance and video retention
24 requirements to also install a

1 drop box there.

2 On Monday the Court of
3 Common Pleas approved one
4 emergency polling place change.
5 Special post-cards will be mailed
6 to every household in that
7 division later this week. Our
8 staff will also hang signs in the
9 Division to let the public know.
10 That was Ward 6, Division 15 from
11 Jamison Court to Delucian
12 Blackwell Community Center (ph).

13 Thank you.

14 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: Thank
15 you.

16 We will now proceed to new
17 business.

18 Any new business?

19 COMMISSIONER SABIR: Yes.
20 Good morning. I motion that we
21 authorize the staff to schedule
22 mobile, mail-in and absentee
23 ballot drop off's that will be
24 staffed by the Board of Elections

1 with the locations and times of
2 those drop offs to be released in
3 advanced.

4 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: Second.
5 All in favor?

6 COMMISSIONER SCHMIDT: I.

7 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: Motion
8 carries.

9 COMMISSIONER SCHMIDT: Madam
10 Chairwoman, I have a motion. I
11 make a motion that we approve the
12 absentee and mail-in ballot
13 challenge procedure document that
14 has been posted on
15 Philadelphiavotes.com and is
16 available at the public comment
17 table, as well as the absentee or
18 mail-in ballot or ballot
19 application challenge form which
20 is also online. It's a required
21 procedure, process, and forms for
22 challenges to applications for
23 absentee and main-in ballots for
24 the 2020 general and special

1 election. Challenges that are not
2 submitted in accordance with the
3 procedures and/or do not utilize
4 the form will not be considered.

5 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: Second.
6 All in favor?

7 COMMISSIONER SCHMIDT: I.

8 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: I have a
9 few motions.

10 Motion number 1, I motion
11 that we approve the joint
12 emergency regulations concerning
13 rules and guidelines for COVID-19
14 safety at polling sites on
15 election day, November 3, 2020.
16 Document that has been posted on
17 Philadelphiavotes.com and is
18 available at the public comment
19 table at the polling place for
20 help and safety guidelines for the
21 2020 general and special election,
22 and direct the staff to place a
23 COVID safety instruction for poll
24 workers on election day, one-pager

1 in the election materials boxes.

2 Do I have a second?

3 COMMISSIONER SCHMIDT:

4 Second.

5 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: All in

6 favor?

7 (All respond I.)

8 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: Motion

9 carries.

10 I have a second motion. I
11 motion that we approve the 2020
12 post-election procedure document
13 that has been posted on
14 Philadelphiavotes.com and is
15 available at the public comment
16 table as the procedures which
17 absentee and mail-in ballot
18 received and sorting, the absentee
19 and mail-in ballots pre canvass
20 and canvass, the express vote XL
21 pre canvass, and the rules for pre
22 canvass and canvass observers for
23 the 2020 general and special
24 election are to be conducted.

1 Do I have a second?

2 COMMISSIONER SCHMIDT:

3 Second.

4 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: All in a
5 favor?

6 (All respond I.)

7 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: Motion 2
8 carried.

9 I have a 3rd motion. I
10 motion that we authorize and
11 deputize the Philadelphia Board of
12 Election staff to prepare for and
13 conduct a pre canvass and canvass
14 of absentee and mail-in ballots at
15 the Philadelphia Convention
16 Center. The absentee and mail-in
17 pre canvass is to begin on
18 election day at 7:00 a.m. and is
19 to be conducted in accordance with
20 the Board's historical practices
21 and procedures, procedures
22 approved here today. The election
23 code and other applicable -- the
24 absentee and mail-in canvass is to

1 begin on or after 8 p.m. on
2 election day, and is to be
3 conducted in accordance with the
4 Board's historical practices and
5 procedures, procedures approved
6 here today, the election code and
7 other applicable laws.

8 The canvass is to begin on
9 Friday, November 7, 2020, at 9:00
10 a.m. Philadelphia Board of
11 Election staff shall take an oath
12 prior to conducting a pre canvass
13 administered by the Board's
14 executive director, and prior to
15 conducting the canvass
16 administered by the Board.

17 Do I have a second?

18 COMMISSIONER SCHMIDT:

19 Second.

20 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: All in
21 favor?

22 COMMISSIONER SCHMIDT: I.

23 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: Motion
24 carried.

1 Motion number 4, in the
2 beginning of 2020 in what hell
3 seems like a 100 years ago in a
4 galaxy far, far away we conducted
5 a contest to redesign the "I
6 Voted" sticker and to implement a
7 "future voter" sticker that can be
8 given to children who go to the
9 polls with their parents.

10 The winner of the contest
11 were Katie Fish and Mickey
12 Lieberman. Then COVID-19 hit and
13 our lives changed. And this vote
14 was delayed. However, this
15 election is the biggest of our
16 lives, all of us, but particularly
17 young people have had so much
18 taken from them this year; summer,
19 vacations, hanging with friends,
20 college and high school
21 experience. With all the things
22 our youth work for and treasure, I
23 did not want them to miss the
24 opportunity to be part of the 2020

1 election. Therefore, I am now
2 going to make a motion to make the
3 new voting stickers official.
4 Also I wanted to note that we pay
5 attention to what people say and
6 we wanted to make sure that we met
7 the public's demand for longer,
8 lasting stickers that actually,
9 well, stick. My team will send
10 examples back to the printer
11 saying no, make them stickier,
12 please. I'm happy to report that
13 my Deputy test drove the sticker
14 last week and it lasted at least
15 seven hours on his suit jacket. I
16 hope that that is sticky enough.

17 As such, I motion that
18 beginning with the November 3,
19 2020 general election and
20 continuing every election until
21 the board rules otherwise the
22 staff shall place in each election
23 materials box an English and
24 Spanish "I Voted" sticker designed

1 by Ms. Katie Fish of Temple
2 University's Tyler School of Art
3 and Architecture and the English
4 and Spanish "Future Voter" sticker
5 designed by Mickey Lieberman of
6 Science and Leadership Academy.

7 I would like to invite Katie
8 and Mickey up to the podium for
9 picture and for them to receive
10 their sticker with well
11 congratulations.

12 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: Before I
13 come down there, I make a motion
14 to approve this new sticker.

15 Do I have a second?

16 COMMISSIONER SCHMIDT:
17 Second.

18 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: All in
19 favor?

20 (All Respond I.)

21 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: Motion
22 carried.

23 (Pause.)

24 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: Anymore

1 new business?

2 COMMISSIONER SCHMIDT: I

3 have none.

4 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY:

5 Commissioner Sabir?

6 COMMISSIONER SABIR: Um,

7 Madam Chair, again, I'd like to

8 say thank you to all the Deputies,

9 all the staff at the Convention

10 Center, people at the Satelight

11 locations, they work really hard

12 to ensure that everyone votes and

13 voices are being heard.

14 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: Thank

15 you.

16 Hearing no more new

17 business, and now that we have a

18 stickier sticker I adjourn this

19 meeting to the call of the chair.

20 Motion to adjourn?

21 COMMISSIONER SABIR: Second.

22 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: All in

23 favor?

24 COMMISSIONER SCHMIDT: I.
