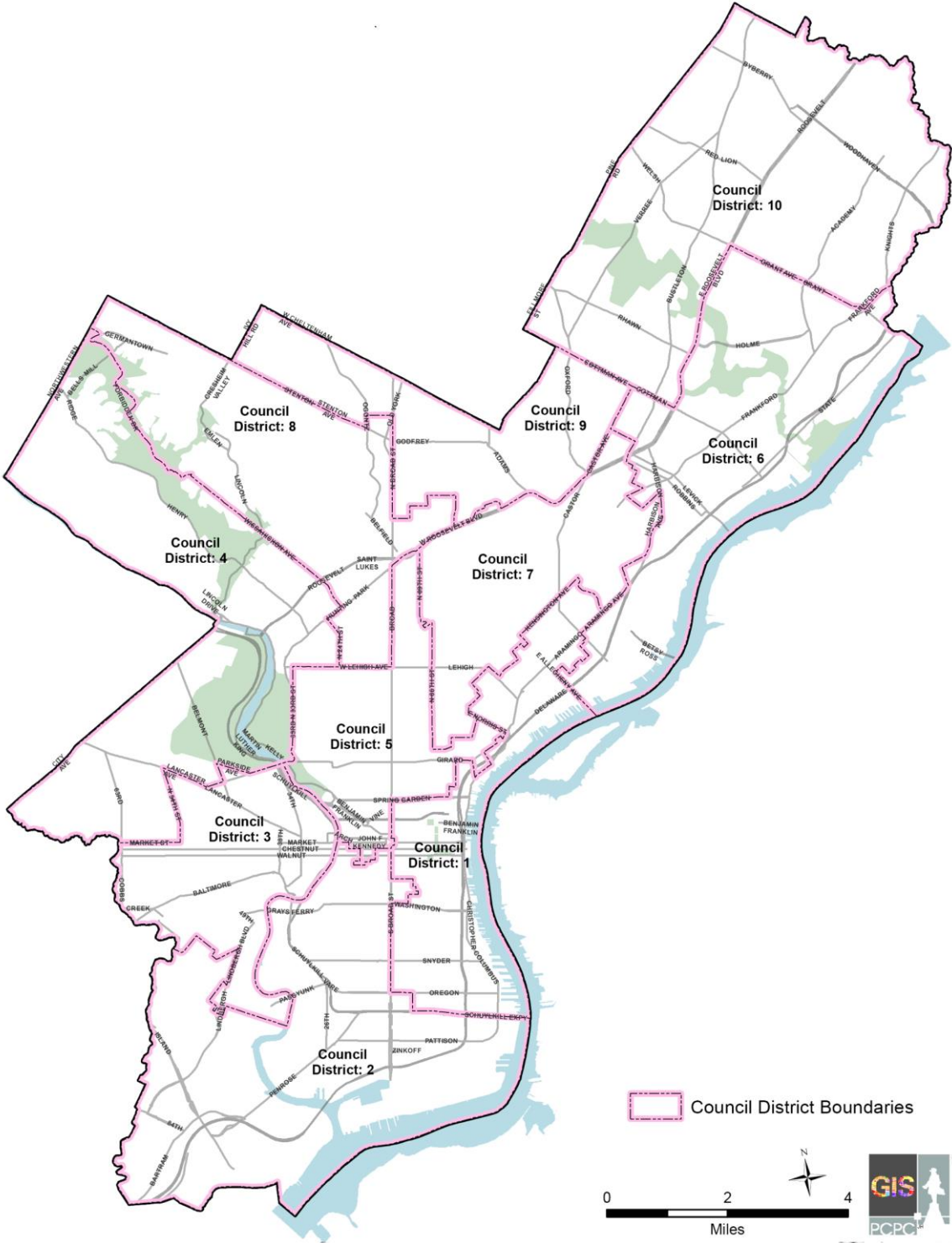

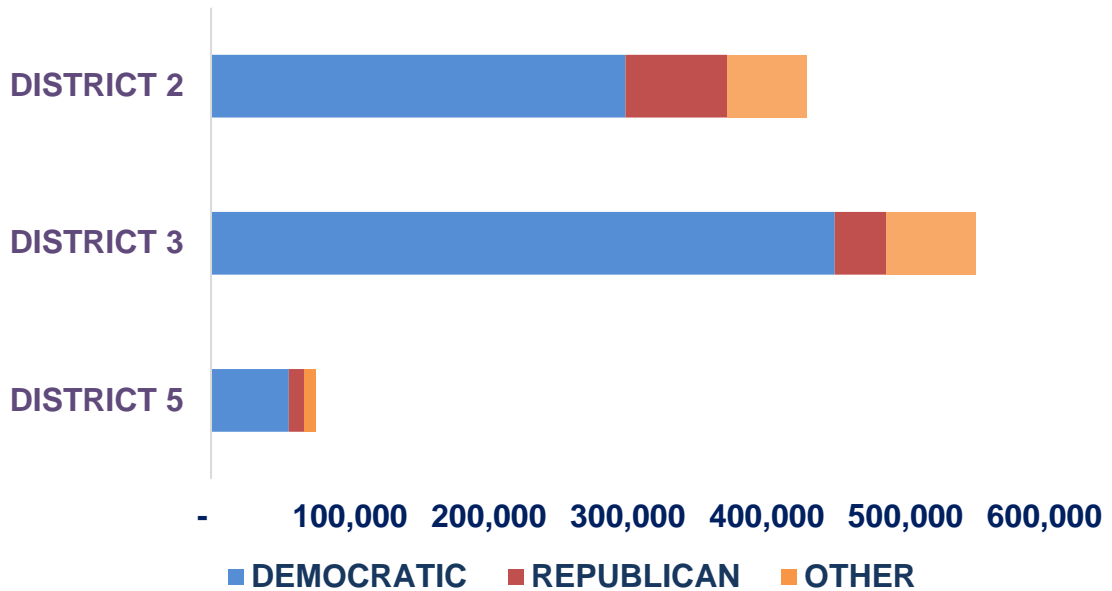
REGISTERED VOTERS IN PHILADELPHIA COUNTY

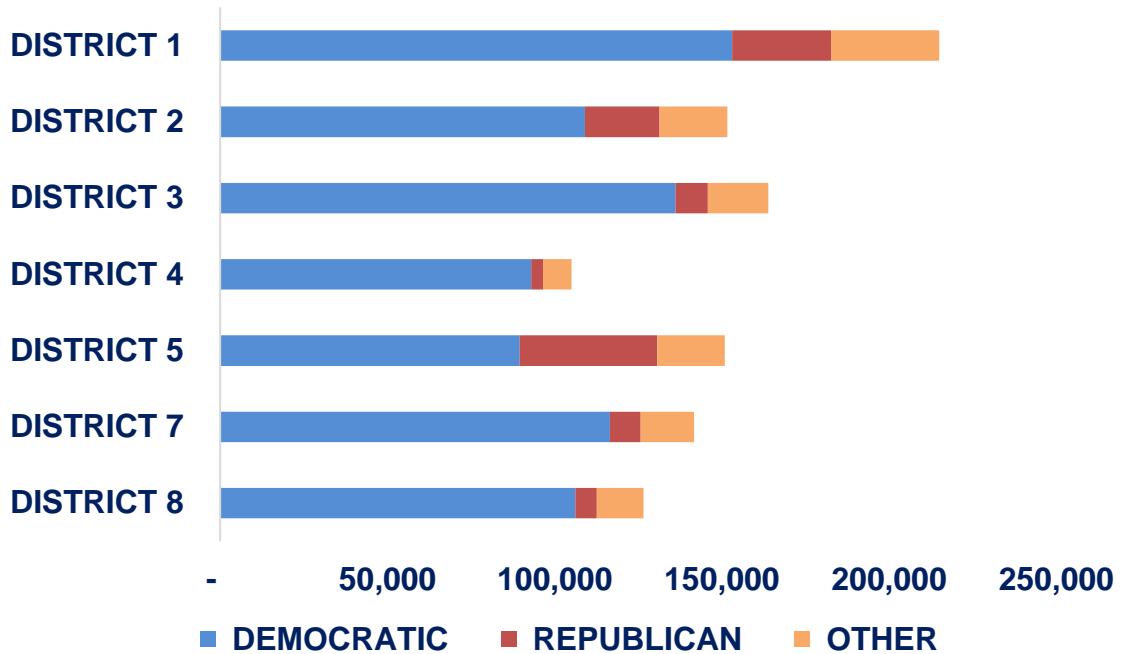

REGISTERED VOTERS BY CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT



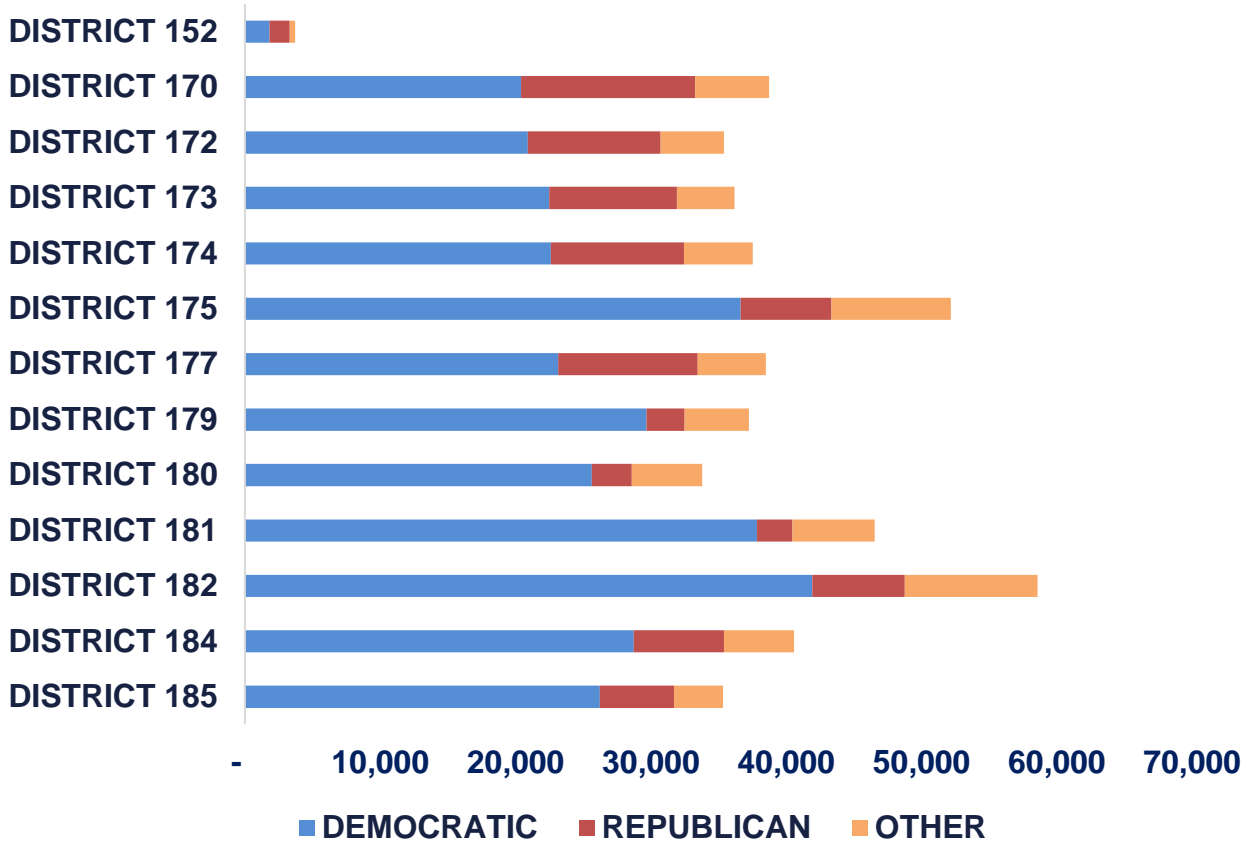

REGISTERED VOTERS BY SENATORIAL DISTRICT



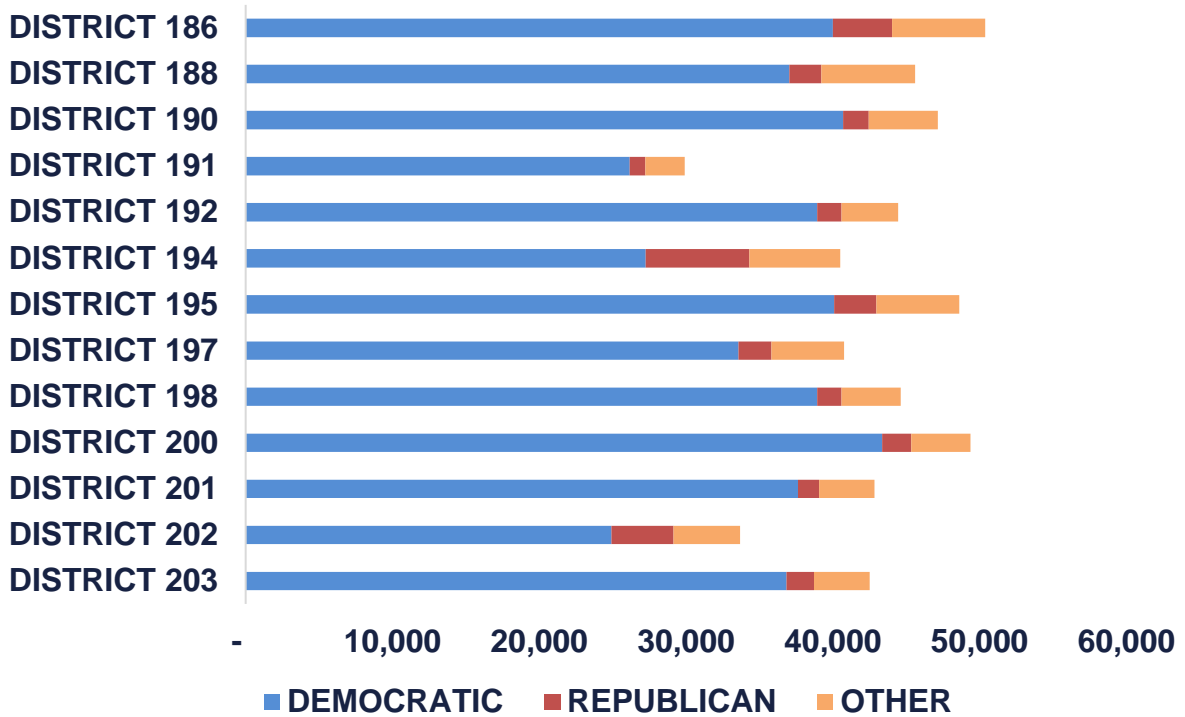

REGISTERED VOTERS BY LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT



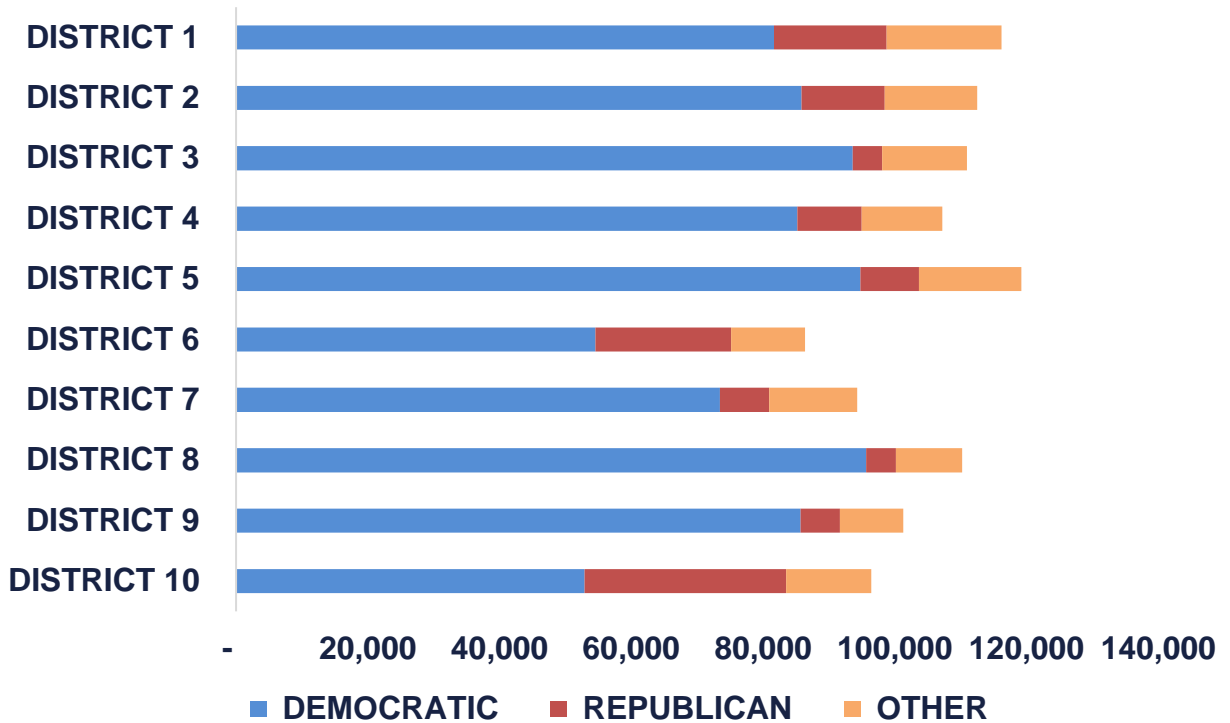

REGISTERED VOTERS BY LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT



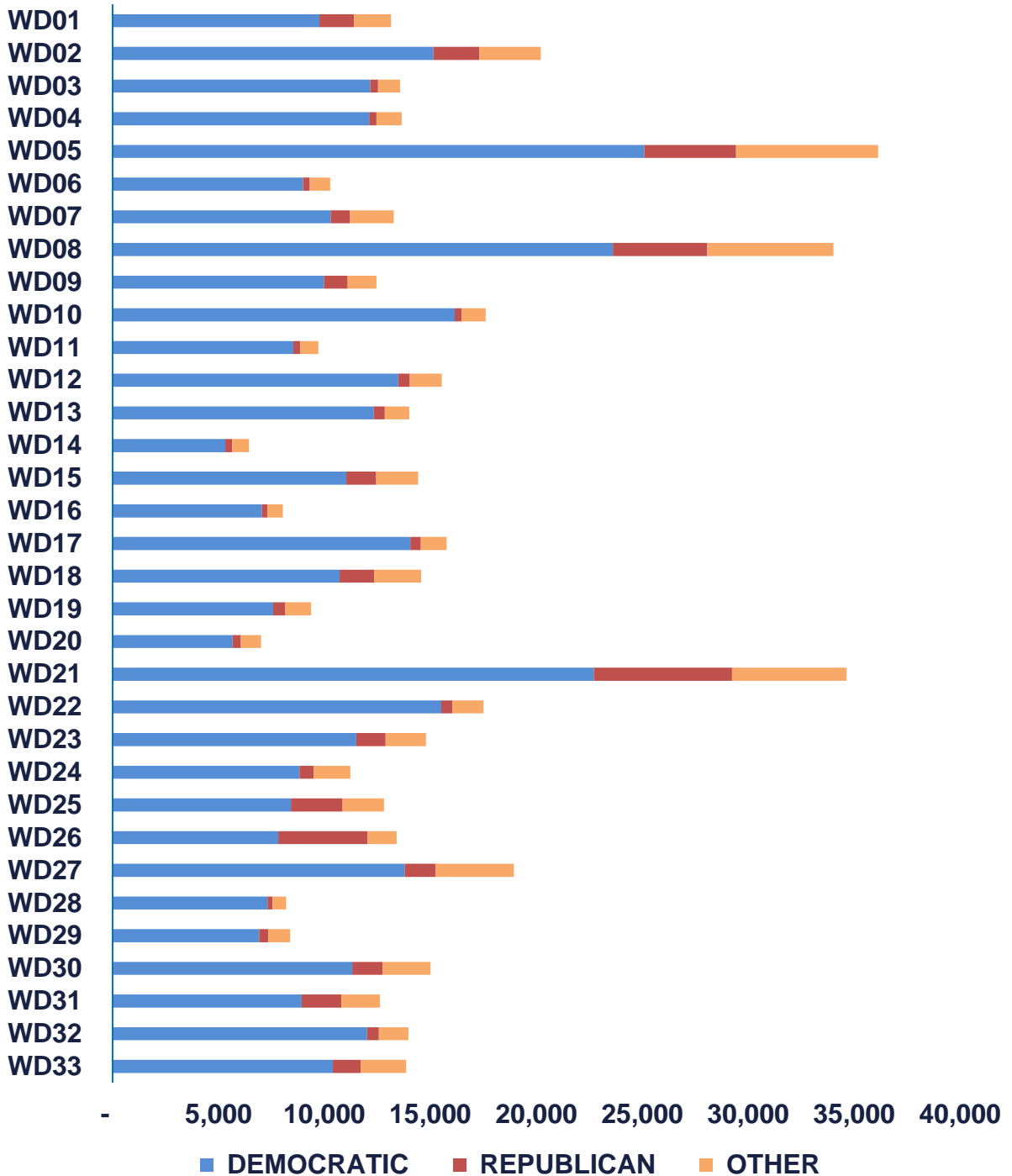

REGISTERED VOTERS BY COUNCIL DISTRICT

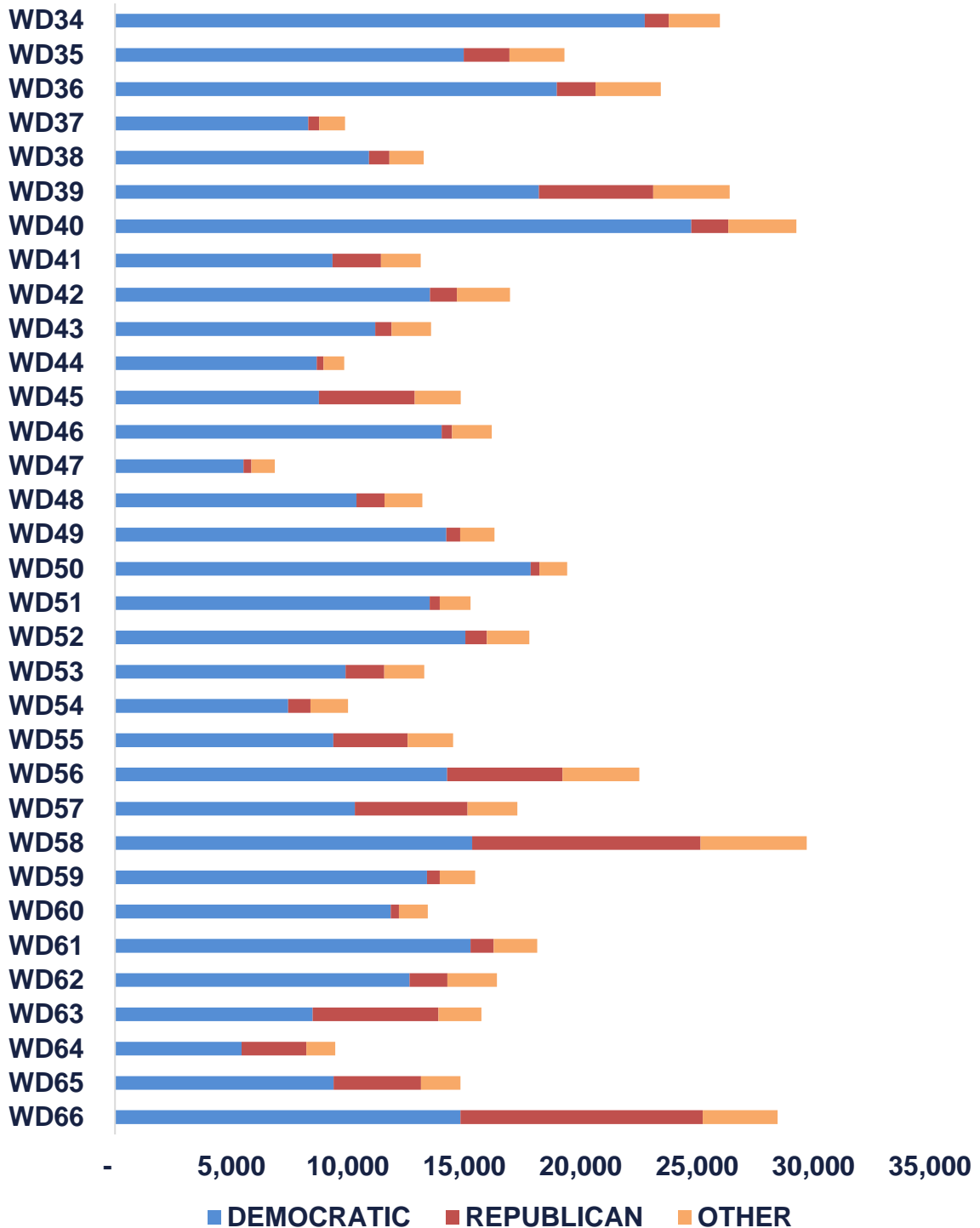

GENERAL INFORMATION

To register to vote in Philadelphia, you must be:

- A citizen of the United States for at least one month before the next election.
- A resident of Philadelphia and your election district for at least 30 days before the next election.
- At least 18 years of age on or before the day of the next election.

Primary Elections: All registered electors are entitled to vote on ballot questions or in special elections held at the same time as primary elections. However, you must be registered in a political party to vote in that party's primary.

Special Elections: Pennsylvania holds special elections when someone in office can no longer serve. This may happen when someone resigns, dies, or gets removed from office. Voters must select someone to replace that person. Everyone who lives in the district the candidates will represent can vote in the special election.

Registering to vote

You can register to vote online, by mail, or at several government agencies, including the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) Photo License and Driver's License Centers.

By Mail: A voter registration application can be obtained by contacting the Philadelphia County Board of Elections at 215-686-3469 or downloading and printing the voter registration application available at philadelphiavotes.com/voters. Additional translations of the voter registration form are also available at philadelphiavotes.com/voters.

Online: Individuals can register to vote through the Pennsylvania Department of State's online application available at www.register.votespa.com.

Voting: Registered voters can vote in-person, by absentee ballot, or by mail-in ballot. All registered voters may request a mail-in ballot for any or no reason. Absentee ballots should be requested by voters with disabilities, an illness, or who will be absent from their municipality on election day. For more information, please visit philadelphiavotes.com/voters or VotesPa.com.

MAIL-IN VOTING

In Pennsylvania, you now have two options for mail ballots:

- **Absentee ballot** – If you plan to be out of the municipality on election day or if you have a disability or illness, you should request an absentee ballot, which still requires you to list a reason for your ballot.
- **Mail-in ballot** – If you aren't an absentee voter, you may apply for a mail-in ballot. You may simply request this ballot.

In order to request a ballot to vote by mail, you must be registered to vote.

1. You can request a mail-in or absentee ballot online at [VotesPA.com/ApplyMailBallot](https://www.votespa.com/ApplyMailBallot) OR you can also request to have an application mailed to you. Contact the Philadelphia County Board of Elections at 215 686-3469 to request an application. You can also contact any of the three City Commissioners' Offices.

NOTE: If you are applying for a mail ballot online, you must provide a PA Driver's License or PennDot ID number.

Registered voters without a Pennsylvania Driver's License or I.D. should download and print an absentee or mail-in ballot application from [VotesPA.com/ApplyMailBallot](https://www.votespa.com/ApplyMailBallot), fill out the form, and mail it to the Philadelphia County Board of Elections.

2. Once you successfully submit your application, the Philadelphia County Board of Elections will mail you your ballot along with instructions. You can check its status by going to pavoterservices.pa.gov or by contacting the Philadelphia County Board of Elections at 215 686-3469. If you apply online, you'll be able to view the status of your application within 48 hours after submitting it.

3. Once you receive your ballot...

- Mark your ballot, following the instructions.
- Place your ballot in the secrecy envelope and then put the secrecy envelope into the official declaration envelope.
- Be sure to sign the form, or your ballot may not count.
- You should mail your ballot as promptly as possible by Election Day or personally deliver it to the County Board of Elections office, satellite office, or drop box no later than 8:00 p.m. on Election Day.

Security: The system has been certified by both the Federal EAC and the Pennsylvania Department of State. As part of the state certification, the system was sent to an independent security consultant for security and penetration testing. Tests were done to ensure that election results, media used, reports, and audit logs were protected from attempts to decrypt, manipulate, or corrupt election data. The system also meets requirements written by the Office of Innovation and Technology security experts. The hardware, election media, and ballots are secured with lock and key and security seals.

Fully ADA-Compliant: Accommodates the full range of human diversity, including physical, perceptual and cognitive abilities. Screen is adjustable for both standing and seated voters. An accessible keypad equipped with braille and the ability to use rocker panel and Sip-and-Puff devices allows voters with disabilities to make selections, to verify their ballot, and cast their votes at the same machines used by all voters.
