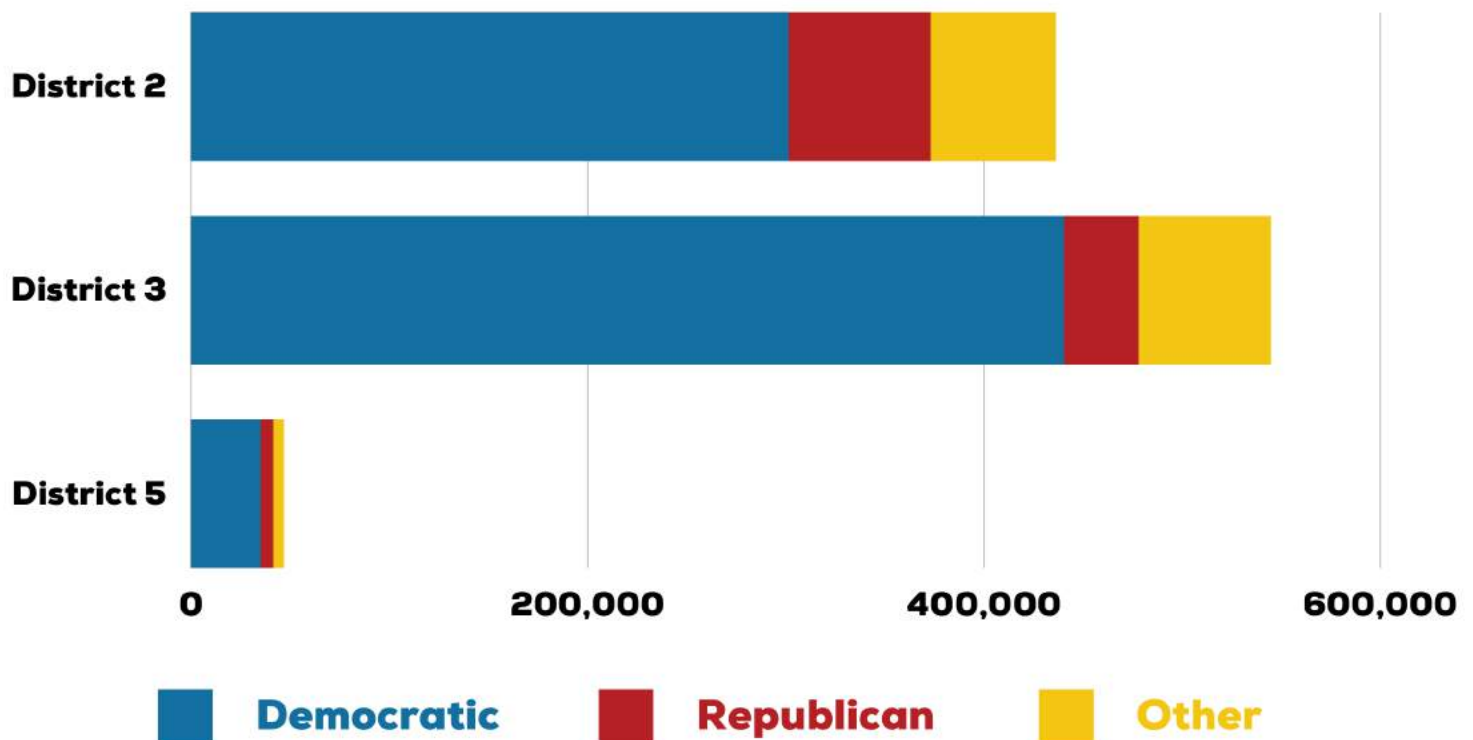

## BY CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT



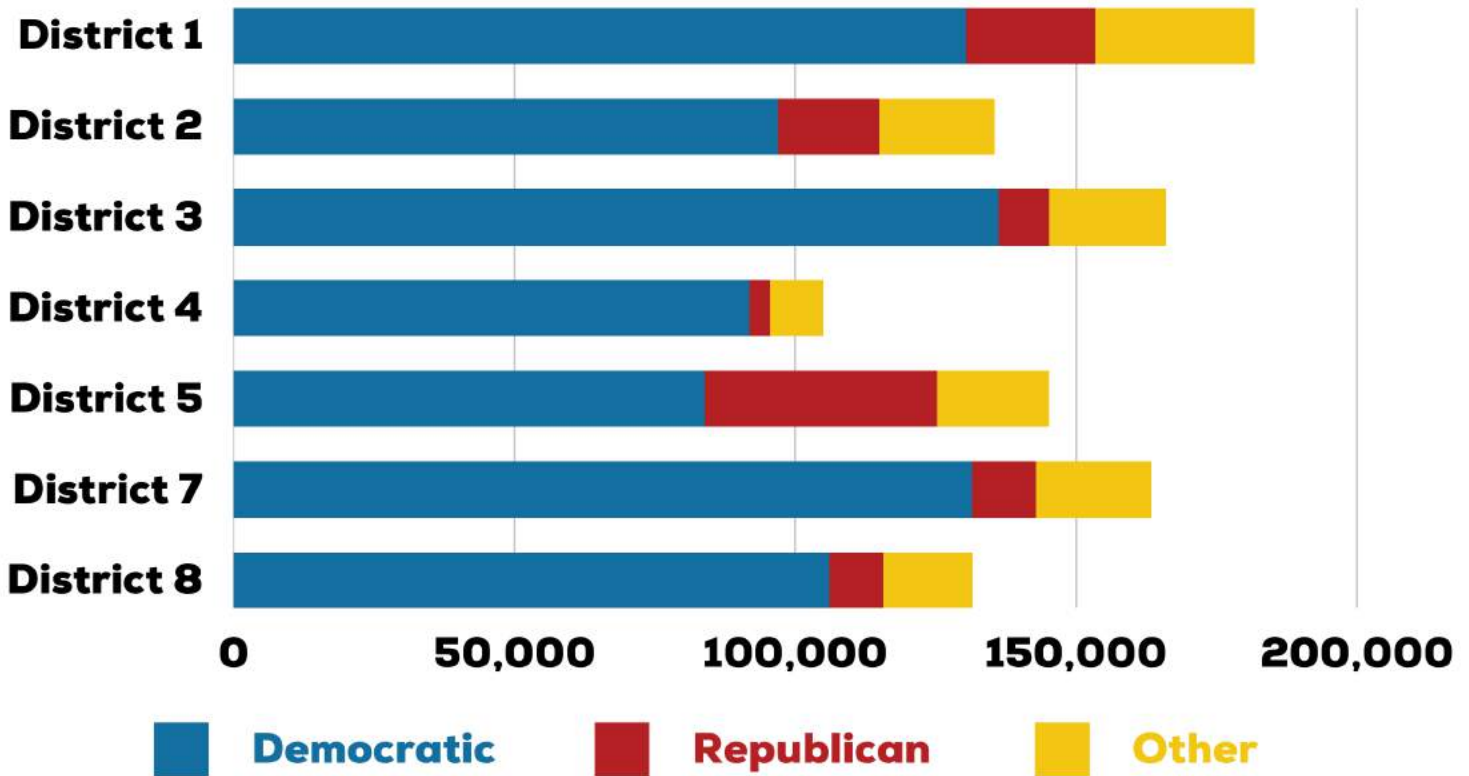

## BY SENATORIAL DISTRICT

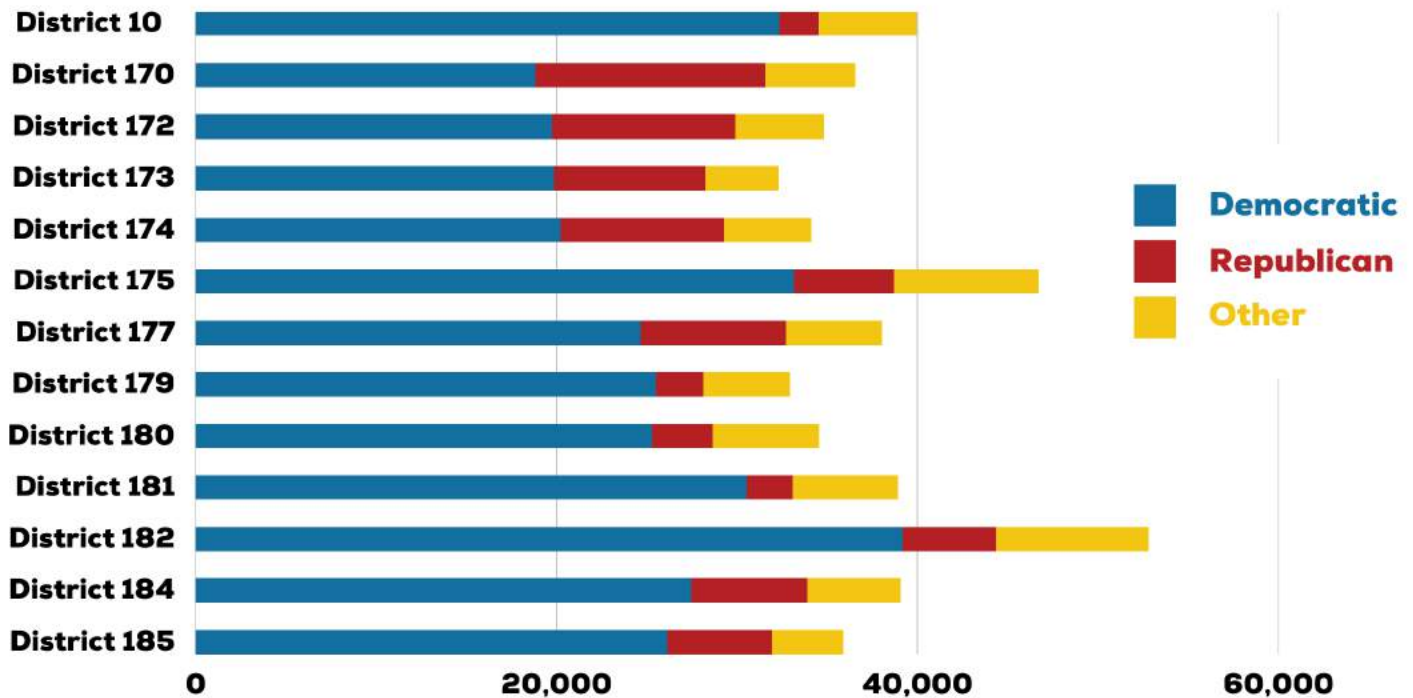

## BY LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT - 10 through 185



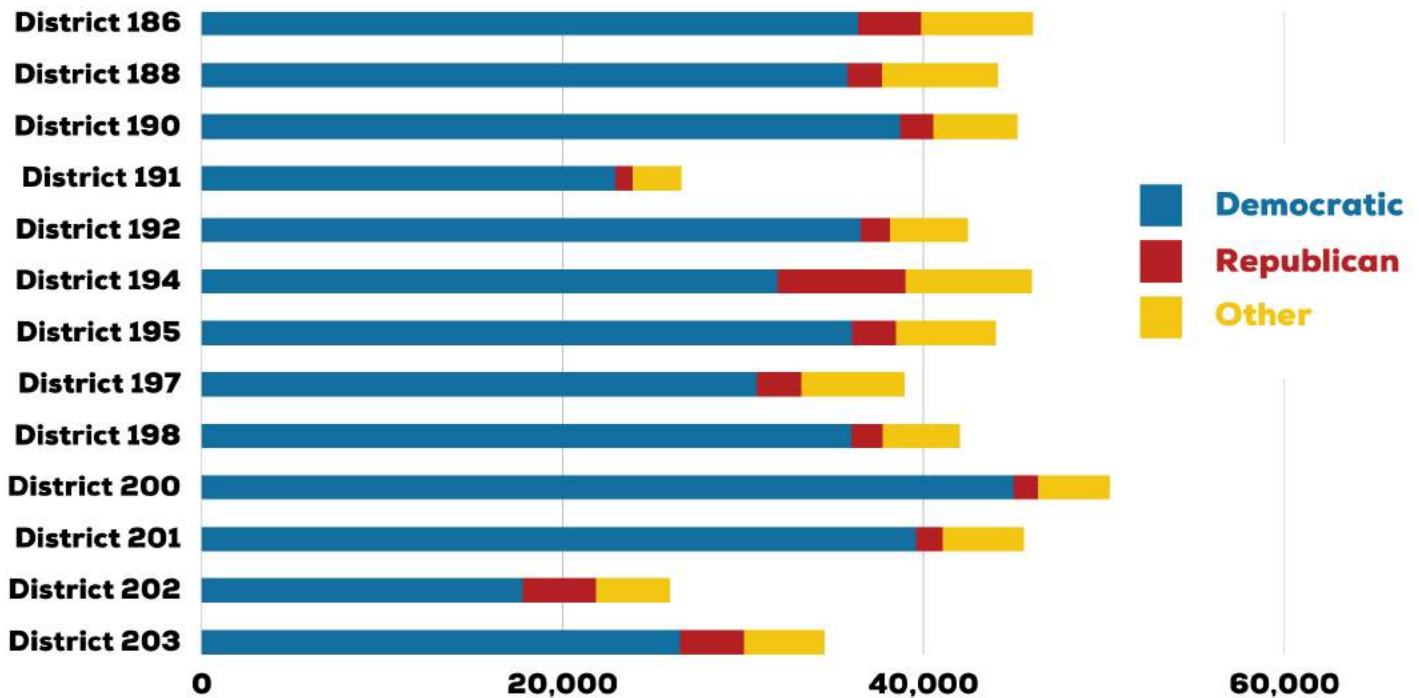

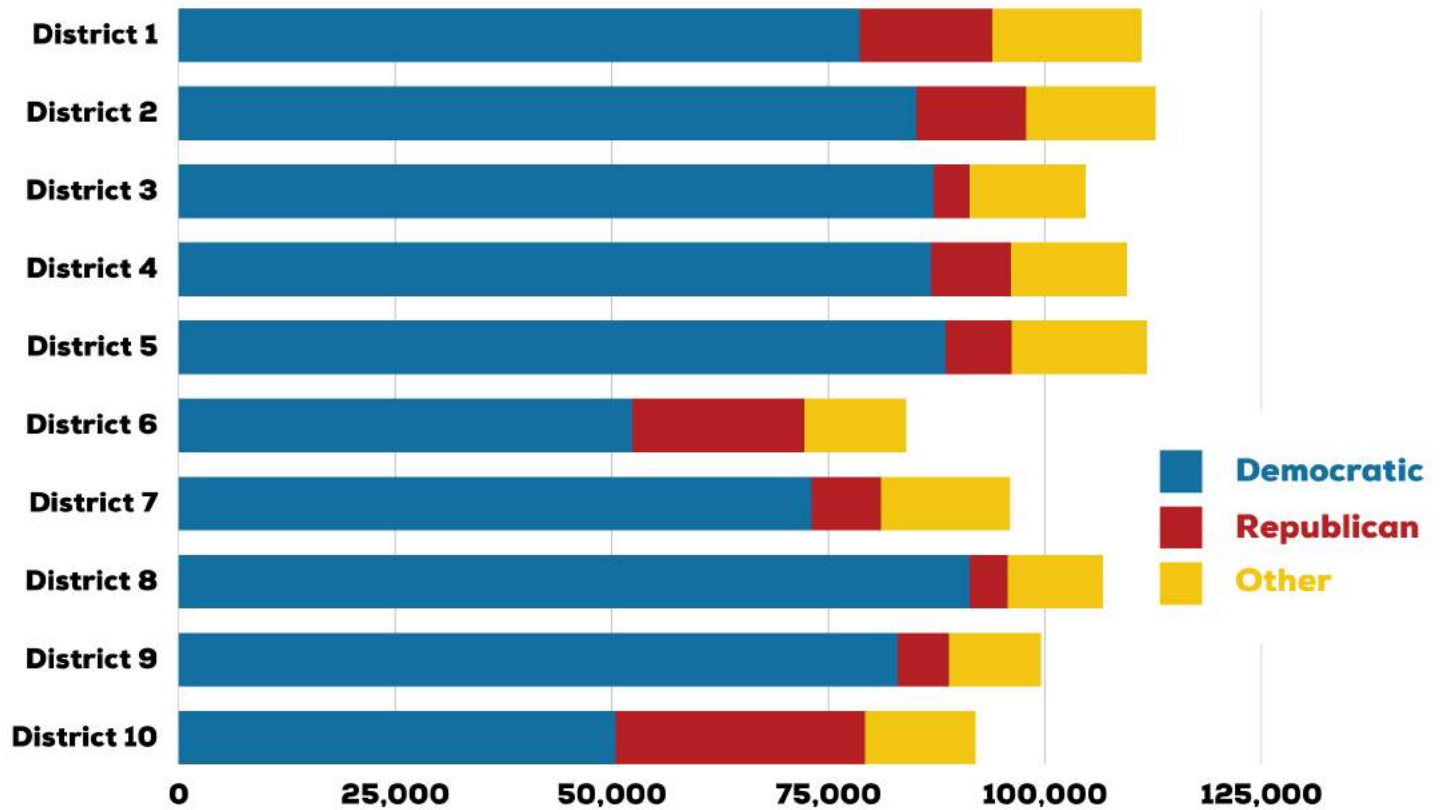

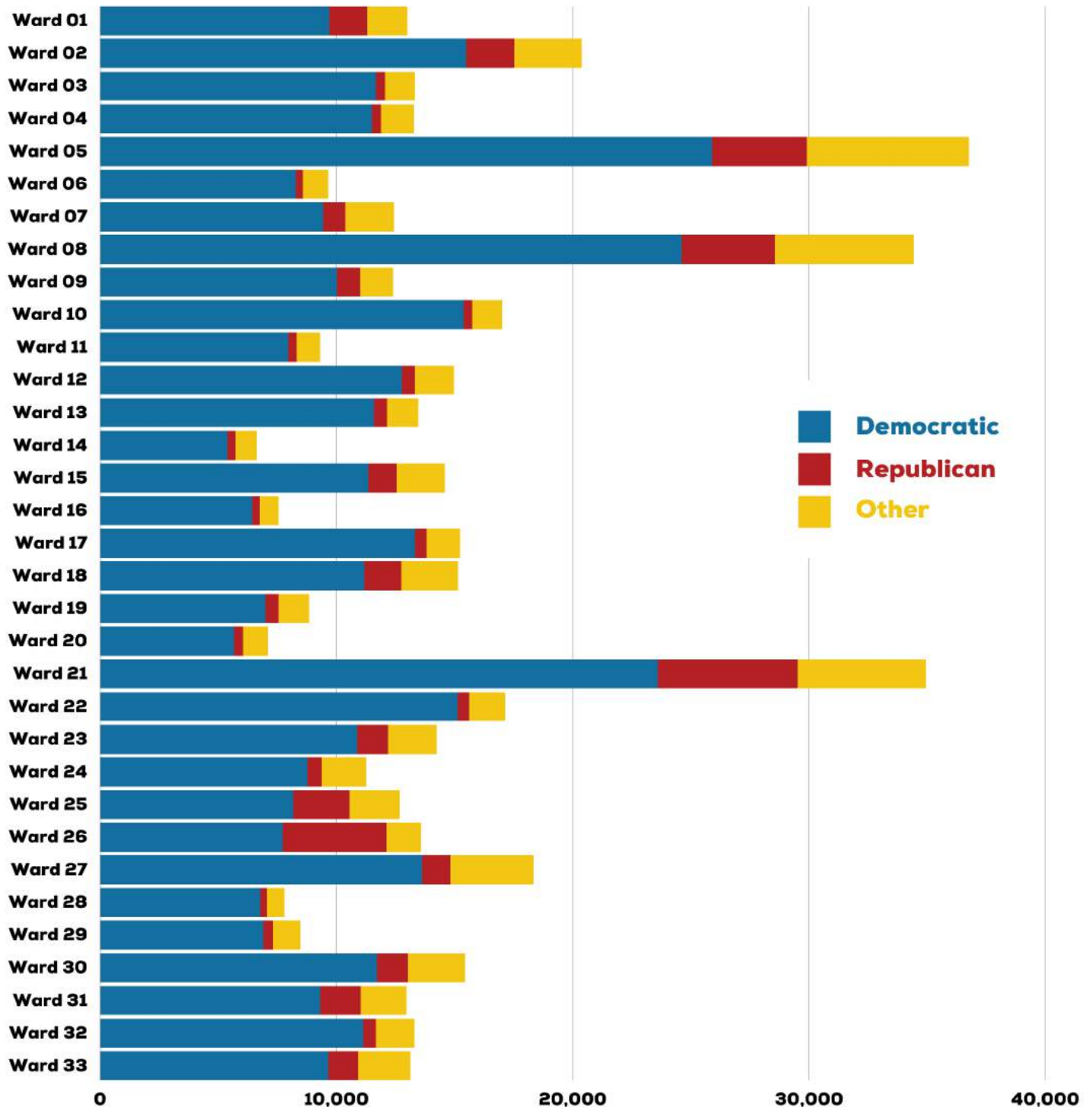

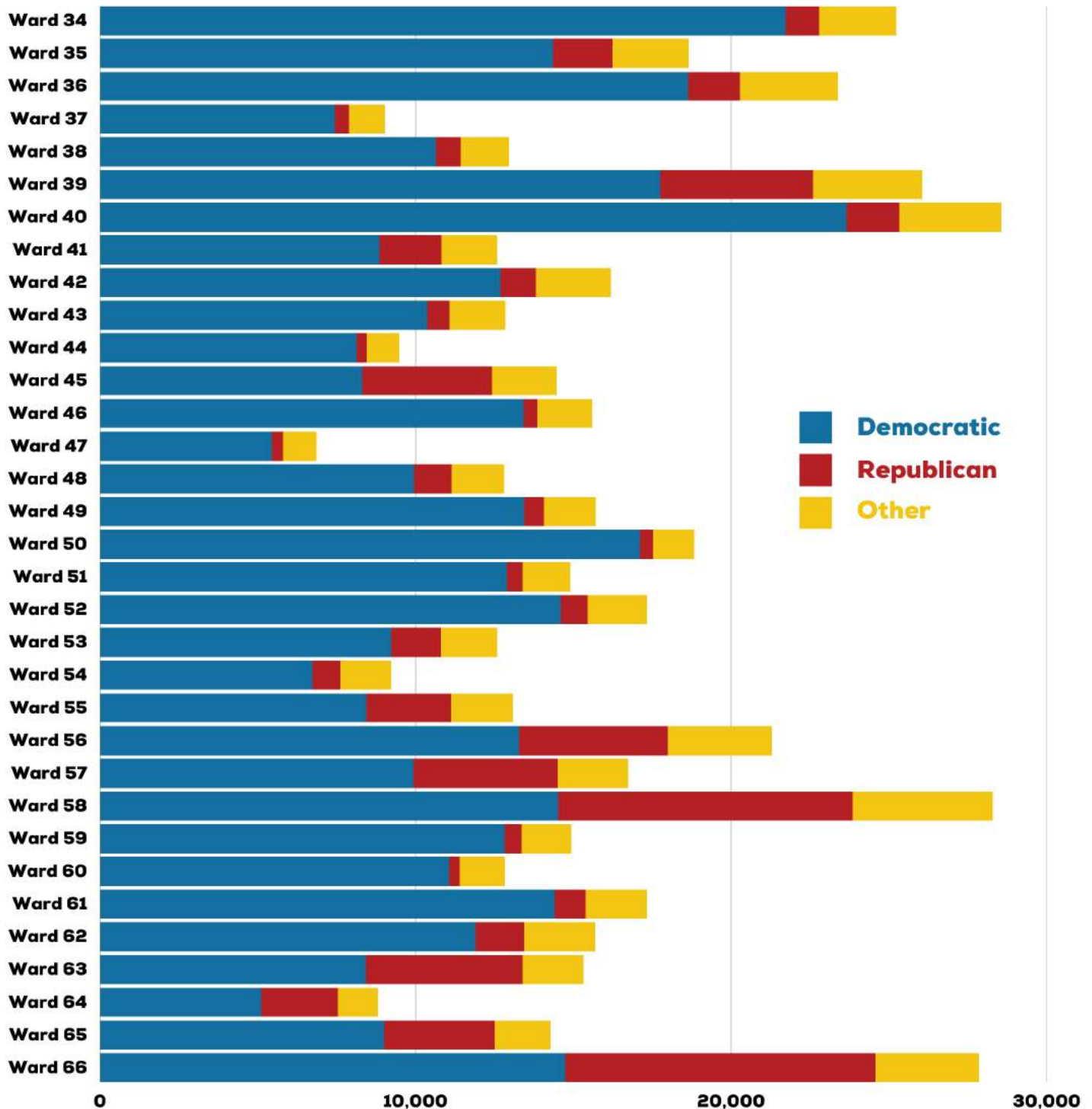

# VOTING IN PHILADELPHIA

## TO REGISTER TO VOTE IN PHILADELPHIA, YOU MUST BE:

- A citizen of the United States for at least one month before the next election.
- A resident of Philadelphia and your election district for at least 30 days before the next election.
- At least 18 years of age on or before the day of the next election.

**Primary Elections:** All registered electors are entitled to vote on ballot questions or in special elections held at the same time as primary elections. However, **you must be registered in a political party** to vote in that party's primary.

**Special Elections:** Pennsylvania holds special elections when someone in office can no longer serve. This may happen when someone resigns, dies, or gets removed from office. Voters must select someone to replace that person. Everyone who lives in the district the candidates will represent can vote in the special election.

## REGISTERING TO VOTE:

You can register to vote online, by mail, or at several government agencies, including PennDOT Photo License and Driver's License Centers.

**Online:** Individuals can register to vote through the Pennsylvania Department of State's online application available at <https://vote.pa.gov>

# MAIL-IN VOTING

In Pennsylvania, you have two options for vote-by-mail ballots:





- **Absentee ballot** – If you plan to be out of the municipality on election day or if you have a disability or illness, you should request an absentee ballot, which still requires you to list a reason for your ballot.
- **Mail-in ballot** – If you are not an absentee voter, you may apply for a mail-in ballot. You may simply request this ballot.

**In order to request a ballot to vote by mail, you must be registered to vote.**

You can request a mail-in or absentee ballot online at <https://vote.pa.gov>, OR you can also request to have an application mailed to you. Contact the **Philadelphia County Board of Elections at (215) 686-3469** to request an application. You can also contact any of the three City Commissioners' Offices. *You can also download and print an absentee or mail-in ballot application from <https://vote.pa.gov>, fill out the form, and mail it to the Philadelphia County Board of Elections.*

2. Once approved, the Philadelphia County Board of Elections will mail you your ballot along with instructions. You can check its status by going to <https://vote.pa.gov> or by contacting the **Philadelphia County Board of Elections at (215) 686-3469**.

# PHILADELPHIA'S VOTING SYSTEM



## 32" FULL-FACED VOTING SURFACE

All candidates will be displayed on one screen, text can be enlarged, contrast can be changed, and voters can toggle between available languages

## VOTER-VERIFIABLE PAPER BALLOT

Voters can verify their ballot before casting their vote and results can be recounted and audited

## PRIVACY CURTAIN, NOT PICTURED

Voters will still have the privacy to cast their ballots behind a curtain

## SECURE BALLOT CONTAINER

Voted paper ballots are stored behind locks and security seals

## BATTERY BACKUP POWER

Can continue to operate in the event of power loss

## EASILY TRANSPORTED

Large, heavy-duty, lockable wheels make for smooth steering and stability

**SECURITY:** The system has been certified by both the Federal EAC and the Pennsylvania Department of State. As part of the state certification, the system was sent to an independent security consultant for security and penetration testing. Tests were done to ensure that election results, media used, reports, and audit logs were protected from attempts to decrypt, manipulate, or corrupt election data. The system also meets requirements written by the Office of Innovation and Technology security experts. The hardware, election media, and ballots are secured with lock and key and security seals.

**FULLY ADA-COMPLIANT:** Accommodates the full range of human diversity, including physical, perceptual and cognitive abilities. Screen is adjustable for both standing and seated voters. An accessible keypad equipped with braille and the ability to use rocker panel and Sip-and-Puff devices allows voters with disabilities to make selections, to verify their ballot, and cast their votes at the same machines used by all voters.



# ELECTRONIC POLL BOOKS

## FASTER CHECK-IN PROCESS

Poll workers will have access to the full division database, with the ability to quickly search by first name, last name, or date of birth

## IMPROVED ACCURACY

of voter check-ins and vote history updates

## ACCOUNTABILITY

Ensure poll workers follow proper procedures related to surrendering mail-in ballots, checking ID, or confirming address before the voter can sign in



**ELECTRONIC POLL BOOKS** are the next step to polling place security.

Workers will have access to the full division voter database, instead of the traditional "two book" split alphabetical system, with the ability to quickly search via a number of different fields. This provides immediate verification that voters are voting on the right machine, in the right division and party, based on their current voter registration.

Electronic poll books can curb voting provisionally as a result of poll workers having trouble locating a voter record.
