2 (6:00 p.m.)

3 CHAIRMAN SABIR: Good evening. I call to order  
4 the meeting of the Philadelphia City Commissioners,  
5 Board of Elections for Tuesday, May 7, 2024. This  
6 meeting is in compliance under the Pennsylvania  
7 Sunshine Act. The Philadelphia City Commissioners are  
8 a three-member bipartisan Board of elected officials  
9 in charge of elections and voter registration for the  
10 County of Philadelphia. Each commissioner is elected  
11 to serve a four-year term that coincides with the  
12 municipal election cycle for mayor and City council.

13 The Commissioners set and enforce  
14 departmental policies to administer voter registration  
15 and conduct elections in accordance with federal and  
16 state voter registration election laws. The City  
17 Commissioners were created by the Pennsylvania  
18 Assembly in 1711 with a focus on taxation and held  
19 various regulatory powers throughout the centuries.  
20 Elected Commissioners started maintaining voter list  
21 in 1799 and took on more election related  
22 responsibilities, but didn't emerge into its current  
23 form until the adoption of the Philadelphia Home Rule  
24 Charter in 1951.

25 We will start off with public comments.

1 Before beginning their comments, commenters shall  
2 state where they live or if they are not a resident of  
3 Philadelphia and that they are a Philadelphia  
4 taxpayer. Public comment is not an opportunity for  
5 dialogue or Q and A. It is public comment, a chance  
6 for you to tell us what you think. Each speaker will  
7 have two minutes to speak, however, I may extend the  
8 time at my discretion. Public comment must concern  
9 matters on today's meeting agenda.

10 Finally, it is my responsibility to preserve the  
11 order and decorum of meetings as such profane,  
12 slanderous, discriminatory, or personal attacks will  
13 not be tolerated.

14 If you wish to make a public objection to a  
15 perceived Sunshine violation, please raise your hand  
16 and I will recognize you. Outbursts will not be  
17 tolerated. Anyone wishing to offer public comment,  
18 please step forward. There are none. We will now  
19 move to report from secretary for email public  
20 comment. Secretary Bluestein, are there any email  
21 public comments there.

22 SECRETARY BLUESTEIN: There were no public  
23 comments emailed by 04:45 p.m.

24 CHAIRMAN SABIR: We will now move to old  
25 business. Provisional ballot sufficiency

1 determinations return mail-in or absentee that was  
2 counted. It was brought to this Board's attention  
3 that last week's return Board meeting on Friday, May  
4 3, 2024, I unintentionally added a word while putting  
5 forth a motion for item number eight under new  
6 business. For the purpose of clarifying the official  
7 record and clarifying to the public, I will now put  
8 forth that same motion again to this Board and we  
9 would duplicate our votes from Friday's meeting to  
10 clear. This is not a new Board action or  
11 determination. This is a simple clarification to  
12 assure that the intent and this will of this Board is  
13 clear.

14 I motion that this Board does not accept ballots  
15 and instances where the voter returned a mail-in or  
16 absentee ballot that was counted. Is there a second?

17 VICE-CHAIR DEELEY: Second

18 CHAIRMAN SABIR: Does anyone want to make a  
19 comment before we vote? No comment. Secretary  
20 Bluestein, please call the roll.

21 SECRETARY BLUESTEIN: Vice-chair Deeley?

22 VICE-CHAIR DEELEY: I vote aye.

23 SECRETARY BLUESTEIN: I vote aye. Chairman
