CHAIRMAN SABIR: Good evening. I call to order the meeting of the Philadelphia City Commissioners, Board of Elections for Tuesday, May 7, 2024. This meeting is in compliance under the Pennsylvania Sunshine Act. The Philadelphia City Commissioners are a three-member bipartisan Board of elected officials in charge of elections and voter registration for the County of Philadelphia. Each commissioner is elected to serve a four-year term that coincides with the municipal election cycle for mayor and City council. The Commissioners set and enforce departmental policies to administer voter registration and conduct elections in accordance with federal and state voter registration election laws. The City Commissioners were created by the Pennsylvania Assembly in 1711 with a focus on taxation and held various regulatory powers throughout the centuries. Elected Commissioners started maintaining voter list in 1799 and took on more election related responsibilities, but didn't emerge into its current form until the adoption of the Philadelphia Home Rule Charter in 1951.

We will start off with public comments.

1 Before beginning their comments, commenters shall
2 state where they live or if they are not a resident of Philadelphia and that they are a Philadelphia taxpayer. Public comment is not an opportunity for dialogue or Q and A .
