Philadelphia City Commissioners sitting as the return

for the primary election of the 2025 primary election.
This meeting is in compliance with the Pennsylvania
Sunshine Act. The Philadelphia City Commissioners are
a three-member bipartisan board in charge of elections
and voter registration for the City of Philadelphia.
Each commissioner is elected to serve a four-year term
that coincides with the municipal election cycle for
Mayor and City Council.
The Commissioners set and enforced departmental
policies to administer voter registration and conduct
elections in accordance with federal and state voter
registration and election laws. The City
Commissioners were created by the Pennsylvania
assembly in 1711 with the focus on taxation, and held
various regulatory powers throughout the centuries.
The Commissioner started maintaining voter lists in
1799 and took on more election-related
responsibilities, but didn't emerge into its current

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- 1 form until the adoption of Philadelphia Home Rule
- 2 Charter in 1951.
