- 1 JUDGE CRUMLISH: I'm Judge
- 2 James Crumlish and I am sitting as Chair of
- 3 the Return Board. With me today also is
- 4 Judge Furlong and Judge Johnson.
- 5 Good afternoon, all. So, first of
- 6 all, I will remind all that it is my duty
- 7 and obligation to preserve order and decorum
- 8 in these meetings. Everyone in attendance
- 9 should be on notice that shouting or
- 10 disruptive conduct won't be tolerated.
- 11 Those who violate this rule may be asked to
- 12 leave.
- 13 The Sunshine Act permits anyone
- 14 attending a public meeting to object to a
- 15 perceived violation at any time during the
- 16 meeting. If you choose to do so, please
- 17 succinctly state your objection and I'll
- 18 remind you that an objection is not an
- 19 opportunity for litigation or speechmaking.
- Next, we will now move to public
- 21 comment. Commentors shall state where they
- 22 live or if they're not a resident of
- 23 Philadelphia that they are a Philadelphia
- 24 taxpayer or since this is the Return Board

- 1 which candidate, if any, they represent.
- 2 Public comments are not an
- 3 opportunity to engage in a dialogue or
- 4 questions and answers with the Board. It is
- 5 public comment. It is a chance for you to
- 6 tell us what you think. Each speaker shall
- 7 have approximately two minutes. However, I
- 8 may in my discretion extend that time. All
- 9 public comments must be relevant or germane
- 10 to the Board and the Board business.
- 11 Finally, it is my responsibility
- 12 to preserve such order and decorum in these
- 13 meetings. And as such, profane, slanderous,
- 14 discriminatory, or ad hominem, that is
- 15 personal attacks, won't be tolerated.
- 16 Anyone wishing to offer a public comment may
- 17 please step forward.
- MR. GARELLA: Good afternoon.
- 19 On behalf -- my name is Rich Garella. On
- 20 behalf of Protect Our Vote Philly, I note
- 21 and object to the serious violations of the
- 22 Pennsylvania Sunshine Act that took place at
- 23 this Board's May 26th meeting.
- In particular, in the course of

- 1 considering whether to accept provisional
- 2 ballots in a category named chain of custody
- 3 issue, members of this Board conversed among
- 4 themselves about the official business at
- 5 hand. This discussion was mostly inaudible
- 6 to the public as the members withdrew from
- 7 the microphones and spoke quietly.
- 8 For the record, portions of that
- 9 conversation included Secretary Furlong
- 10 asking, Yeah, what is that, chain of
- 11 custody? And is this where they left it in
- 12 the trunk of the ward leader's car? And
- 13 mentioning the River Wards.
- 14 Chair Crumlish participated but
- 15 his responses are inaudible except when he
- 16 says, True story. There's more but if any
- 17 of these quotations are not accurate, I
- 18 invite you to correct them now so that they
- 19 appear accurately on the transcript.
- 20 This Board violated the Sunshine
- 21 Act by deliberating out of hearing of the
- 22 public at a supposedly open meeting. In
- 23 addition, it withheld from the public the
- 24 number of votes being considered; the

- 1 division, the division for wards where their
- 2 chain of custody issue supposedly took place
- 3 and the nature of the issues. The public
- 4 was left with no way to understand what was
- 5 being voted on or what the basis of the
- 6 Board's decision was.
- 7 Candidates were left with no way
- 8 to know if the issues may have impacted
- 9 their results or if these provisional
- 10 ballots were even present during the
- 11 election code mandated observation period,
- 12 that is whether election code was also
- 13 violated.
- 14 These are serious violations that
- 15 undermine trust and the integrity of our
- 16 elections along with the very evident lack
- of documented chain of custody procedures.
- 18 We urge the Board to explain now exactly
- 19 what happened and to create actual chain of
- 20 custody protections that are documented for
- 21 the public. Thank you.
- JUDGE CRUMLISH: Thank you.
- 23 Judge Furlong, do we have any public
- 24 comments that have been e-mailed?

- JUDGE FURLONG: Thank you,
- 2 Mr. Chairman. Judge Crumlish, as of 9:45
- 3 a.m., the City Commissioners Office received
- 4 no public comments via e-mail.
- 5 JUDGE CRUMLISH: Thank you
- 6 very much, Judge Furlong. Having said that,
- 7 we'll now move to new business which is the
- 8 category signing of the certification for
- 9 the 2023 primary election.
- 10 The record will reflect that Judge
- 11 Johnson, Judge Furlong, and myself have
- 12 executed the Certificate of Elections for
- 13 the primary election of 2023. Judge
- 14 Furlong, do we have any additional agenda
- 15 items?
- JUDGE FURLONG: No, your
- 17 Honor.
- 18 JUDGE CRUMLISH: Judge
- 19 Johnson, do we have any additional agenda
- 20 items?
- JUDGE JOHNSON: No, Mr.
- 22 Chairman.
- JUDGE CRUMLISH: We will
- 24 stand in recess until the call of the Chair.
