- ² everyone. I'm going to call to order the
- 3 September 13, 2023 meeting of the Philadelphia
- ⁴ County Board of Elections. And, as you know,
- ⁵ it is my obligation to conduct this meeting
- 6 and consistent with the fashion, that not only
- ⁷ the business of the county board gets done
- ⁸ properly, but also that the public is given an
- ⁹ opportunity to watch these proceedings. Now,
- the public is invited to object during the
- 11 course of this meeting and to assert comments,
- 12 as well. So anyone may object during the
- meeting to perceive violation of the public
- 14 meeting law. If you do so, state your
- objection concisely and, again, do it so in
- 16 such a manner that you do not obstruct the
- ordinary process of the meeting. So having
- 18 said that, public comment is not an
- opportunity for -- to filibuster or obstruct
- this meeting, as I have said. A speaker who
- has a comment in this public part of the
- hearing is expected to not use more than two
- ²³ minutes as it's the business of the commission
- has to be conducted in an efficient matter.
- So, again, any public comments have to be

- 1 relative -- relevant or germane to this
- ² meeting's process and, therefore, we do not
- 3 allow ad hominem or personal attacks or
- ⁴ arguments to be made. And having said that,
- ⁵ do we have anyone here present that wants to
- 6 make a public comment that is germane to the
- ⁷ proceedings of the commission? Hearing none,
- ⁸ Judge Furlong, I'm going to call on you now to
- ⁹ report to the extent that you had any email
- 10 public comments.
- JUDGE FURLONG: Thank you, Mr.
- 12 Chairman. All comments that were emailed by
- 9:45 a.m. today were shared with members of
- 14 the board and the deputies at 10 a.m. have
- been provided to each member of the board at
- the beginning of the meeting and are available
- 17 for com -- for at a public comment table. We
- 18 received one comment from Maria Serna. I
- 19 reviewed the comment and asked that it be
- ²⁰ moved into the record.
- JUDGE CRUMLISH: Yes. And
- 22 consistent with that comment, as it is brief,
- ²³ Judge Furlong, can you read that comment for
- ²⁴ us?
- JUDGE FURLONG: Sure. This is

- 1 from Maria Serna. She inquires, I want more
- ² information about how immigrant communities
- 3 can participate in the Philadelphia County
- ⁴ Board of Elections. She signs it Maria Serna.
- JUDGE CRUMLISH: I will request
- ⁶ that the professional staff of the commission
- ⁷ reach out for Mr. Serna and communicate with
- 8 her our efforts to continue to enhance
- 9 participation of the electors in our community
- in the city county of Philadelphia. So I
- 11 appreciate that input.
- Next, I would call on Executive
- 13 Director Lynch. Mr. Lynch, you may read the
- 14 executive director report.
- MR. LYNCH: Good afternoon, your
- 16 Honors. Good afternoon, audience. The
- Sunshine Report for September 13, 2023, the
- 18 County Board Of Elections Report. The County
- 19 Board of Elections is now accepting mail-in
- ²⁰ and absentee ballot applications. Voters will
- need to complete and return their application
- to the County Board of Election by October
- 31st to vote by mail for the general election.
- Voters may apply online at vote.phila.gov
- ²⁵ rather than returning the paper application.

- 1 As of yesterday, we have approved 83,769 vote
- 2 by mail applications. Of those, 50,887 are
- paper applications and 32,882 are electronic
- 4 applications. This includes civilian overseas
- ⁵ and military voters. Of those, 58 electronic
- 6 applications are waiting to be processed.
- ⁷ Tuesday, September 26, 2023, is the deadline
- 8 for filing Cycle 4, six Tuesday pre-general
- 9 campaign finance reports. Cycle 4 includes
- transactions through September 18th, 2023.
- 11 All candidate committees and political
- 12 committees that have made expenditures to
- influence a city election must file a report.
- 14 Voter registration union, the election cycle
- ¹⁵ 77,995 voter registration applications have
- been processed. 35,707 ID cards have been
- mailed out to date. The unit is also stuffing
- 18 instruction cards and secrecy envelopes in
- 19 their outer -- outer envelopes. The unit is
- ²⁰ currently under construction, so
- 21 accommodations are being made for the safety
- of the employees and the public. The election
- 23 board unit trainings for upcoming general
- ²⁴ election started on September 5th. The
- carpenter's union hall had 170 board workers

- 1 attend the first week of classes. This week
- ² they're doing trainings at Mariana Bracetti
- 3 school. Election poll book refresher
- ⁴ trainings are being held every Friday at our
- ⁵ Delaware and Spring Garden location on the
- 6 sixth floor. That's all I have.
- JUDGE CRUMLISH: Thank you very
- 8 much, sir. Deputy Commissioner Kapenstein,
- ⁹ would you please give the deputy report,
- 10 please?
- MR. KAPENSTEIN: Hello, your
- 12 Honors. In keeping with the requirements of
- 13 2022's language access expansion motion, the
- deputy commissioners have prepared a report on
- the number of ballots cast in Spanish and
- 16 Chinese on ExpressVote XLs in the 2023 primary
- 17 at the division level. There was a total of
- 18 1,938 ballots cast on the ExpressVote XLs in
- 19 Spanish and 291 ballots cast in Chinese.
- There was a total of 203,842 ballots cast on
- the ExpressVote XLs in English. There were
- 22 170 voters who either applied to vote by mail
- in Spanish or who had previously identified a
- 24 preference for receiving voting materials in
- ²⁵ Spanish. Of those, 107 ballots were returned

- ¹ and counted. There were similarly 82
- ² applications for Chinese ballots, of which 48
- were returned and counted. There were 96,010
- 4 ballots requested by voters who didn't specify
- ⁵ a language preference, of which 72,703 were
- ⁶ returned and counted. The deputy
- 7 commissioners hosted a meeting of the language
- 8 access advisory committee yesterday in
- ⁹ preparation for the upcoming municipal
- 10 election. We were pleased by the
- 11 participation of community representatives and
- 12 look forward to meeting again after the
- election to receive additional feedback. And
- 14 that's all I have for you.
- JUDGE CRUMLISH: Thank you. So
- having said that, we have any new business? I
- do have a motion I'd like to make. I'd like
- to move that the stipend for attending the
- 19 electronic poll book refresher training course
- 20 be set 30. Do I hear a --
- JUDGE FURLONG: Second I.
- JUDGE CRUMLISH: I also vote in
- ²³ favor of the motion a quorum having been
- 24 present, the motion passes. We have the form
- of motion? We'll move on. So Judge Furlong,
