1 JUDGE CRUMLISH: Good
2 afternoon. I'll call to order the meeting
3 of September 20th for the Philadelphia
4 County Board of Elections.

5 First, as you know, it is my duty
6 and responsibility to ensure the decorum and
7 orderly process of these meetings. Everyone
8 at these meetings should be aware that
9 interruptions will not be tolerated and
10 those who violate the rules will be asked to
11 leave.

12 The Sunshine Act permits anyone
13 attending a public meeting to object to a
14 perceived violation at the time of the
15 meeting. If you choose to do so, please
16 succinctly state your objection. Objecting,
17 however, is not an opportunity for
18 litigating, political issues, or
19 speechmaking.

20 With respect to public comment,
21 we'll now move to public comment. Those who
22 wish to make public comment who are present
23 here shall state where they live or if
24 they're not a resident of Philadelphia that

1 they are a Philadelphia taxpayer. Public
2 comment is not an opportunity for an
3 extended dialogue or questions and answers
4 with the commissioners. It's a public
5 comment; a chance for you to tell us what
6 you think.

7 Each speaker may be allowed two
8 minutes. However, I may have the
9 opportunity, obligation, and right to
10 moderate that amount of time. All public
11 comments must be relevant or germane to this
12 Board's business.

13 Finally, again, it's my
14 responsibility to preserve the order and
15 decorum of the meetings and I add that we
16 will not tolerate profane, slanderous,
17 discriminatory, or personal attacks. Is
18 there anyone here today for public comment?

19 (No response).

20 JUDGE CRUMLISH: Hearing
21 none, I will now move to Judge Furlong for
22 e-mail public comment. Judge Furlong?

23 JUDGE FURLONG: Chairman, as
24 of 9:45 a.m. this morning, there have been

1 no public comments e-mailed to the
2 Commission.

3 JUDGE CRUMLISH: Thank you,
4 Judge Furlong. We'll now move on to old
5 business. I'm going to call on Mr. Lynch,
6 Director Lynch, to read the executive
7 director's report. Mr. Lynch?

8 MR. LYNCH: Good afternoon,
9 your Honors. Today's Sunshine report for
10 September 20, 2023, the County Board report.
11 The County Board of Elections is now
12 accepting mail-in and absentee ballot
13 applications. Voters will need to complete
14 and return their applications to the County
15 Board of Elections Office by October 31st to
16 vote by mail for the general election.
17 Voters may apply online at vote.phila.gov
18 rather than returning the paper
19 applications.

20 As of yesterday, we have approved
21 84,015 vote by mail applications. Of those,
22 50,790 are paper applications and 33,225 are
23 electronic applications. This includes
24 civilians, overseas, and military voters.

1 We have a total of 997 applications waiting
2 to be processed. Of those, 903 are paper
3 applications and 94 are electronic
4 applications.

5 Tuesday, September 26, 2023 is the
6 deadline for Cycle 4, 6 Tuesday pregeneral
7 campaign finance reports. Cycle 4 includes
8 transactions through September 18, 2023.

9 All candidate committees and political
10 committees that have made expenditures to
11 influence the city election must file a
12 report.

13 The Election Board Unit. The
14 Election Board Unit is out at West
15 Philadelphia High School conducting training
16 this week. To date, the unit has trained
17 in-person 436 workers. 180 workers have
18 taken the online training. Data from the
19 primary payroll has been uploaded in Phila
20 Van and calls to recruit more workers
21 started this past Monday, the 18th. That's
22 all I have.

23 JUDGE CRUMLISH: Thank you,
24 Director. Hearing nothing else on old

1 business, we'll now move to new business.
2 I'll call on Mr. Stroman to present fully
3 placed relocations. Is there anyone here
4 who would like to speak on the moving of any
5 particular polling place? You may, ma'am,
6 identify yourself. Do we have a microphone?

7 MS. CARR: Good afternoon.

8 My name is Charlene Carr. I am a trustee
9 and member at 1814 Wharton Street and the
10 petition is for it to be moved from the
11 post, I believe, back to our church and we
12 are accepting it coming back.

13 JUDGE CRUMLISH: So, Mr.

14 Stroman?

15 MR. STROMAN: Good morning,
16 Judges, or afternoon I should say. I'm
17 going to move to the first one that that
18 young lady just spoke about. That would be
19 in the 36th Ward, 9th Division, moving out
20 of Lincoln Post 89 to the Trinity United
21 Methodist Church. That is moving back into
22 its own division.

23 JUDGE CRUMLISH: So hearing
24 no other objection, I would move to approve

1 the application of the Commission to move
2 the polling place interdivision to the
3 Trinity United Methodist Church on Wharton
4 Street. Judge Furlong, do I have a second?

5 JUDGE FURLONG: Yes.

6 JUDGE CRUMLISH: All in favor
7 including Judge Johnson?

8 (Aye).

9 JUDGE CRUMLISH: So moved and
10 approved.

11 MS. CARR: Thank you.

12 JUDGE CRUMLISH: Thank you,
13 ma'am. Mr. Stroman, you may continue.

14 MR. STROMAN: Okay. I'm
15 going to move to the top of your page, your
16 Honor. Ward 3, Division 17. Moving out of
17 Blanche Nixon Library due to construction to
18 the Turner School. That's Ward 3, Division
19 17.

20 JUDGE CRUMLISH: I would move
21 for the movement of this to 318 Turner
22 School. Do I hear a second?

23 JUDGE JOHNSON: I'll second
24 it.

1 JUDGE CRUMLISH: All in
2 favor?

3 (Aye).

4 JUDGE CRUMLISH: So moved and
5 approved. Mr. Stroman?

6 MR. STROMAN: The next one is
7 in the 3rd Ward, 21st Division, moving out
8 of the Francis Myers Rec Center due to
9 construction to the Bethany Baptist Church.

10 JUDGE CRUMLISH: And I would
11 move that 5127 to the Bethany Baptist Church
12 be adopted by the Commission.

13 JUDGE FURLONG: Second.

14 JUDGE CRUMLISH: I would so
15 move. All in favor?

16 (Aye).

17 JUDGE CRUMLISH: The transfer
18 is approved by unanimous vote of the
19 Commission.

20 MR. STROMAN: Next one is the
21 3rd Ward again, the 22nd Division, moving
22 out of Longstreth School due to overcrowding
23 to the Bethany Baptist Church.

24 JUDGE CRUMLISH: So I would

1 move to confirm the move to 5127 to the
2 Bethany Baptist Church at 5747 Warrington
3 Avenue. Do I hear a second?

4 JUDGE FURLONG: Second.

5 JUDGE CRUMLISH: All in
6 favor?

7 (Aye).

8 JUDGE CRUMLISH: So approved.

9 MR. STROMAN: Next one is in
10 the 5th Ward, the 20th Division, moving out
11 of the Rodgar Egis Library to the St. John
12 Neumann Center in Fishtown. That is back
13 into its own ward.

14 JUDGE CRUMLISH: I would move
15 to accept 5th Ward, Division 20 to be moved
16 to the St. John Neumann Center. Do I hear a
17 second?

18 JUDGE FURLONG: Second.

19 JUDGE CRUMLISH: All in
20 favor?

21 (Aye).

22 JUDGE CRUMLISH: So moved and
23 agreed by the Commission.

24 MR. STROMAN: Next two are in

9/20/2023

1 the 7th Ward. It'll be the 10th Division
2 and the 16th Division. Both moving out of
3 McVeigh Rec Center due to construction to
4 the Elkin School which they were there
5 formerly.

6 JUDGE CRUMLISH: I would move
7 to accept the recommended change from
8 polling place for Ward 7, Division 10 and
9 Ward 7, Division 16. 7 and 10 to the Elkin
10 School, 31st District, and also 07-16 also
11 to the Elkin School. All in favor -- or do
12 I hear a second? Sorry.

13 JUDGE JOHNSON: Second on
14 both.

15 JUDGE FURLONG: Aye.

16 JUDGE JOHNSON: Aye.

17 JUDGE CRUMLISH: The motion
18 is adopted. The polling place is approved
19 by the Commission.

20 MR. STROMAN: Next one would
21 be in the 10th Ward, the 16th Division and
22 the 27th Division. Moving out of the Shop
23 H&H Community Center due to a refusal to the
24 Paragon Banquet Hall. That would be

1 Division 16 and 27 out of the 10th Ward.

2 JUDGE CRUMLISH: I would move
3 to accept the recommendation to move the
4 10th Ward, 27th Division and also the 10th
5 Ward, 16th Division, to the Paragon Banquet
6 Hall as recommended.

7 JUDGE JOHNSON: Second on
8 both.

9 JUDGE CRUMLISH: All in
10 favor?

11 (Aye).

12 MR. STROMAN: Next one would
13 be in the 10th Ward again, the 20th
14 Division. Moving out of the Paragon Banquet
15 Hall to Building 21 School and that's back
16 to the original location.

17 JUDGE CRUMLISH: I would move
18 to accept the recommendation of the movement
19 of Ward 10, Division 20 to the Building 21
20 School on 6501 Limekiln Pike. Do I hear a
21 second?

22 JUDGE JOHNSON: Second.

23 JUDGE CRUMLISH: All in
24 favor?

2 MR. STROMAN: Next three are
3 in the 25th Ward; the 11th Division, the
4 16th Division, and the 22nd Division. All
5 moving out of Cohocksink Rec Center due to
6 construction to the Richmond Elementary
7 School.

8 JUDGE CRUMLISH: I would move
9 to accept the recommendation to move the
10 polling place Division -- Ward 25; Divisions
11 11, 16, and 22 to the Richmond Elementary
12 School. Do I hear a second?

13 JUDGE FURLONG: Second on all
14 three.

15 JUDGE CRUMLISH: All in
16 favor?

17 (Aye).

18 JUDGE CRUMLISH: The
19 recommendation has been approved by the
20 Commission.

21 MR. STROMAN: The next one
22 would be in the 35th Ward, the 9th Division
23 and the 12th Division. Moving out of the
24 Lawncrest Library due to construction to the

1 Lawncrest Recreation Center just next door.

2 JUDGE CRUMLISH: So I would
3 move to accept the recommendation to move
4 Ward 35, Division 9 to the Lawncrest
5 Recreation Center. Do I hear a second?

6 JUDGE JOHNSON: Second.

7 JUDGE CRUMLISH: All in
8 favor?

9 (Aye).

10 JUDGE CRUMLISH: The motion
11 is accepted.

12 MR. STROMAN: The next one
13 will be in the 46th Ward, the 11th Division.
14 Moving out of the Harrington School to the
15 Christy Rec Center and that is moving back
16 into its own ward.

17 JUDGE CRUMLISH: So I move to
18 accept the recommendation as to Ward 46,
19 Division 11 to move the polling place to the
20 Christy Recreation Center, 728 South 55th
21 Street.

22 JUDGE FURLONG: Second.

23 JUDGE CRUMLISH: All in
24 favor?

2 JUDGE CRUMLISH: The
3 recommendation is adopted by the Commission.

4 MR. STROMAN: Next one will
5 be in the 49th Ward, the 10th Division and
6 the 19th Division. Moving out of the
7 Lindley Academy Charter School, this is due
8 to a refusal, to the Thurgood Marshall
9 School.

10 JUDGE CRUMLISH: I would move
11 to accept the recommendation to move the
12 polling places of the 49th Ward, 19th
13 Division and the 49th Ward, Division 10 to
14 the Thurgood Marshall School at 5120 North
15 6th Street. Do I hear a second?

16 JUDGE FURLONG: Second on
17 both.

18 JUDGE CRUMLISH: All in
19 favor?

20 (Aye).

21 JUDGE CRUMLISH: The motion
22 is adopted. The polling place has been
23 adopted.

24 MR. STROMAN: Next one will

9/20/2023

1 be in the 51st Ward, 1st Division. Moving
2 out of Blanche Nixon Library to the
3 Harrington School.

4 JUDGE CRUMLISH: I would move
5 the change of polling place for Ward 51,
6 Division 1 to the Harrington School which is
7 5300 Baltimore Avenue. Do I hear a second?

8 JUDGE FURLONG: Second.

9 JUDGE CRUMLISH: All in
10 favor?

11 (Aye).

12 JUDGE CRUMLISH: The motion
13 is adopted. The polling place change has
14 been adopted.

15 MR. STROMAN: The next one
16 would be in the 51st Ward; 21st Division,
17 22nd Division, 24th Division, and 25th
18 Division. All moving back to the Mitchell
19 School and this is due to construction.

20 JUDGE CRUMLISH: I would move
21 that Ward 51, Division 21; Ward 51, Division
22 22; Ward 51, Division 24; and Ward 51,
23 Division 25 all be moved by recommendation
24 to the Mitchell School at 5500 Kingsessing

1 Highway. Do I hear a second?

2 JUDGE FURLONG: Second on
3 all.

4 (Aye).

5 JUDGE CRUMLISH: Motion is
6 approved. The recommended changes have been
7 approved by the Commission.

8 MR. STROMAN: Next one will
9 be in the 52nd Ward, the 11th Division and
10 the 12th Division. Moving out of the
11 Settlement Music School back to the Inglis
12 House and that is back to the original
13 location.

14 JUDGE CRUMLISH: I would move
15 that the recommended polling place change of
16 52-11 and 52-12 be moved to the Inglis House
17 which is 2600 Belmont Avenue. Do I hear a
18 second?

19 JUDGE FURLONG: Second.

20 JUDGE CRUMLISH: All in
21 favor?

22 (Aye).

23 JUDGE CRUMLISH: The polling
24 place changes have been approved by the

1 Commission.

2 MR. STROMAN: One more, your
3 Honor. The last one is in the 49th Ward,
4 the 15th Division. Moving out of Lindley
5 Academy Charter to the Cooke Middle School.

6 JUDGE CRUMLISH: I would move
7 to adopt the recommended polling place
8 change of 49-15 to the Cooke Middle School
9 at 1300 Loudon Street. Do I hear a second?

10 JUDGE JOHNSON: Second.

11 JUDGE CRUMLISH: All in
12 favor?

13 (Aye).

14 JUDGE CRUMLISH: Are there
15 any additional non-agenda items,
16 Commissioners?

17 JUDGE FURLONG: No.

18 JUDGE CRUMLISH: Judge
19 Johnson, nothing more?

20 JUDGE JOHNSON: No.

21 JUDGE CRUMLISH: I'm going to
22 announce that the Commission at the
23 convenience of its counsel will meet in
24 executive session to discuss pending

1 litigation. Other than that, do we hear
2 anything further?

3 (No response).

4 JUDGE CRUMLISH: Do I hear a
5 motion to adjourn?

6 JUDGE JOHNSON: Motion,
7 second.

11 JUDGE CRUMLISH: God bless.
