| 17 | enforce departmental policies to administer | |
| 18 | voter registration and conduct elections in | |
| 19 | accordance with federal and state voter | |
| 20 | registration and election laws. | |
| 21 | The City Commissioners were | |
| 22 | created by the Pennsylvania Assembly in 1711 | |
| 23 | with a focus on taxation and held various | |
| 24 | regulatory powers throughout the centuries. | |
| 25 | The Commissioners started maintaining voter | |

| lists in 1799 and took on more |

| election-related responsibilities, but |
| didn't emerge into its current form until |
| the adoption of Philadelphia Home Rule |
| Charter in 1951. |
