- 1 JUDGE CRUMLISH: Good
- 2 afternoon, everyone. I'm going to call to
- 3 order the November 8, 2023 meeting of the
- 4 Philadelphia County Board of Elections. As
- 5 you all know, I am duty bound to preserve
- 6 the order and decorum of these meetings and
- 7 everyone in attendance should be on notice
- 8 that interruptions or disrupting this
- 9 proceeding won't be tolerated. Those who
- 10 violate it may be asked to leave.
- 11 The Sunshine Act permits anyone
- 12 attending a public meeting to object to a
- 13 perceived violation at any time during the
- 14 meeting. And if you choose to do so, please
- 15 succinctly state your objection and
- 16 objecting is not, as I remind people, an
- 17 opportunity to litigate or have long
- 18 speeches.
- 19 Having said that, we'll now move
- 20 to public comment. Commentors, if any,
- 21 shall state where they live, or if they're
- 22 not a resident of Philadelphia that they are
- 23 a Philadelphia taxpayer. Public comment,
- 24 however, is not an opportunity for dialogue,

- 1 interrogation, or a question and answer. It
- 2 is a public comment; a chance for you to
- 3 tell us what you think.
- 4 Speakers shall have approximately
- 5 two minutes. However, I may extend this
- 6 time at my discretion. I remind all public
- 7 comments must be relevant or germane to
- 8 Board business. Finally, it is also, as
- 9 I've said, my responsibility to preserve the
- 10 order and dignity of this proceeding. And
- 11 as such, profane, slanderous,
- 12 discriminatory, or personal attacks will not
- 13 be tolerated.
- Now, I call on the public to see
- if anyone has a public comment to make.
- 16 Yes? Come up to the mic if you will. Good
- morning.
- MS. LOUGHREY: Good morning.
- 19 My name is Marnie Aument Loughrey. I'm the
- 20 Democratic Ward leader of the 33rd Ward,
- 21 Kensington Juniata. I live at 722 East
- 22 Willard Street.
- 23 My comment or my question is one
- of my judges of elections in 33-17 had to

- 1 send two poll workers home because the City
- 2 Commissioners sent student poll workers to
- 3 her polling place. They are 17-year-old
- 4 people who normally would not be eligible to
- 5 work 'cause they're not 18 years old and
- 6 registered voters. And now her people are
- 7 not sure if they're going to come back for
- 8 the next election because they were sent
- 9 home from this election.
- 10 My question is why is the City
- 11 Commissioner's Office sending students to
- 12 polling locations for spots to work?
- JUDGE CRUMLISH: So thank you
- 14 very much for your public comment. We will
- 15 have the professional staff of the
- 16 Commissioner's Office follow up on that with
- 17 you.
- MS. LOUGHREY: Thank you.
- JUDGE CRUMLISH: Thank you
- 20 very much. Now we'll move on to any e-mail
- 21 public comments. Judge Furlong, do we have
- 22 any e-mail public comments?
- JUDGE FURLONG: Thank you,
- 24 Mr. Chairman. All comments that were

- 1 e-mailed by 9:45 a.m. were shared with
- 2 Members of the Board and the deputies at
- 3 10:00 a.m. and have been provided to each
- 4 Member of the Board at the beginning of the
- 5 meeting and are available at the public
- 6 comment table.
- 7 We received one comment from Larry
- 8 West. I've reviewed the comment and ask
- 9 that it be moved into the record.
- 10 JUDGE CRUMLISH: I second
- 11 that motion. I move that the public comment
- 12 that has been e-mailed in be made a part of
- 13 the permanent record of the City
- 14 Commissioners sitting as the Board of
- 15 Elections. All in favor?
- 16 (Aye).
- 17 JUDGE CRUMLISH: So moved and
- 18 accepted. Anything further, Judge Furlong?
- JUDGE FURLONG: No.
- 20 JUDGE CRUMLISH: I will now
- 21 call on Director Lynch to read the report
- 22 from the executive director. Director
- 23 Lynch?
- 24 MR. LYNCH: I'll just make

- 1 this short and sweet. Yesterday went
- 2 smooth. I mean, we had the usual problems,
- 3 you know, things that they thought were
- 4 missing and they really weren't. The poll
- 5 books, it was the second time we rolled them
- 6 out and it was a huge success. I mean,
- 7 yesterday was smooth as could be. That's
- 8 all I have to say.
- JUDGE CRUMLISH: Director
- 10 Lynch, I would ask on behalf of the judges
- 11 sitting as commissioners for you to commend
- 12 the professional staff of the Commission for
- 13 their hard work and even the temporaries and
- 14 volunteers. It is a collective effort on
- 15 behalf of our community and we depend on you
- 16 and all of those serving to execute the
- 17 complex and professional operations and they
- 18 are done with impressive fealty to their
- 19 oath of office as well as their duties to
- 20 the public. So give them thanks from us,
- 21 please.
- MR. LYNCH: I will. Thank
- 23 you. Thanks for your support.
- 24 JUDGE CRUMLISH: Judge
