Finally, it is my responsibility 13 to preserve again, as you know, the order 14 and dignity of this proceeding which is an important public meeting so therefore we 15 16 will prohibit and not allow slanderous, discriminatory, or personal attacks. 17 Ιt 18 won't be tolerated.

19 If there is anyone here who has 20 requests or concerns in regard to the 21 general and special election on Tuesday, 22 November 7, 2023 or would like to put 23 anything else on the public record in regard 24 to the general election or special election,
