17	The Commission was set to enforce departmental
18	policies to administer voter registration and conduct
19	elections in accordance with Pennsylvania and state
20	voter registration election laws. The City
21	Commissioners were created by the Pennsylvania
22	assembly in 1711 with a focus on taxation and held
23	various regulatory powers throughout the centuries.
24	The Commissioners started maintaining voter lists in
25	1799, and took on more election related

- 1 responsibilities, but didn't emerge into its current
- 2 form until the adoption of Philadelphia Home Rule
- 3 Charter in 1951.
- 4 We will start off with public comments. Before
