4 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: Good morning. I
5 call to order the Return Board for the 2022
6 General and Special Election, and we have
7 reconvened.

8 First, I will preserve the order and
9 decorum of these meetings. Everyone in
10 attendance should be on notice that shouting
11 out or interrupting the proceedings will not
12 be tolerated. Those who violate this will be
13 asked to leave.

14 The Sunshine Act permits anyone
15 attending a public meeting to object to a
16 perceived violation at any time during the
17 meeting. If you choose to do so, please
18 succinctly state your objection. Objecting is
19 not an opportunity for speechmaking.

20 We'll now move to public comment.
21 Commenters shall state where they live, or, if
22 they're not a resident of Philadelphia, that
23 they're a Philadelphia taxpayer. Or, since
24 this is the Return Board, which candidate they

1 represent.

2 Public comment is not an opportunity
3 for dialogue or Q&A. It's public comment. A
4 chance for you to tell us what you think.
5 Each speaker shall have two minutes, however,
6 I may extend this time at my discretion.

7 All public comment must be relevant or
8 germane to board business.

9 Finally it's my responsibility to
10 preserve the order and decorum of the
11 meetings. As such, profane, slanderous,
12 discriminatory or personal attacks will not be
13 tolerated.

14 Anyone wishing to offer public comment,
15 please step forward. We will now move to
16 Commissioner Bluestein for e-mailed public
17 comment.

18 COMMISSIONER BLUESTEIN: There were no
19 e-mailed public comments.

20 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: In an attempt to
21 correct the issue in 1405, the staff
22 accidentally scanned the wrong ballot. This was
23 discovered in a 2 percent audit and corrected.

24 This correction has changed the numbers

1 for the canvass and computation for 1405
2 Congressional, Second District question one
3 and question two.

4 I call on Dana Ekra (ph) to read the
5 amended results of the canvass and computation
6 for 1405 Congressional, Second District
7 question one and question two.

8 MS. EKRA: Representative in Congress
9 Second District: Brendan F. Boyle, 156.

10 Erin Bashir, Republican: 8.

11 Write-in Totals: 0.

12 Question One: Yes, 112. No, 30.

13 Question Two: Yes, 114. No, 28.

14 CHAIRWOMAN DEELEY: Thank you. We will
