

1 JUDGE CRUMLISH: The Return
2 Board for the 2023 General and Special
3 Election has reconvened. First, I will
4 preserve the order and decorum of these
5 meetings. Everyone in attendance should be
6 on notice that shouting out or interrupting
7 the proceedings will not be tolerated.
8 Those who violate this will be asked to
9 leave.

10 The Sunshine Act permits anyone
11 attending a public meeting to object to a
12 perceived violation at any time during the
13 meeting. If you choose to do so, please
14 succinctly state your objection. Objecting
15 is not an opportunity for speechmaking.

16 We now will move to public
17 comment. Commentors shall state where they
18 live or if they are not a resident of
19 Philadelphia that they are a Philadelphia
20 taxpayer or, since this is the Return Board,
21 which candidate they represent. Public
22 comment is not an opportunity for dialogue
23 or Q&A. It is public comment; a chance for
24 you to tell us what you think.

1 Each speaker shall have two
2 minutes. However, I may extend this time at
3 my discretion. All public comments must be
4 relevant or germane to board business.
5 Finally, it is my responsibility to preserve
6 the order and decorum of the meetings. As
7 such, profane, slanderous, discriminatory,
8 or personal attacks will not be tolerated.
9 Anyone wishing to offer public comment,
10 please step forward.

11 (No response).

12 JUDGE CRUMLISH: We will now
13 move to Judge Furlong for e-mailed public
14 comments. We will now sign the
15 certification for 2023 General Election.
16 Judge Furlong, do you have any items to add
17 to the agenda?

18 JUDGE FURLONG: No.

19 JUDGE CRUMLISH: Judge
20 Johnson, do you have any items to add
21 to the agenda?

22 JUDGE JOHNSON: No.

23 JUDGE CRUMLISH: Thank you.
