CALENDAR FOR THE SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD DURING THE 2022 GENERAL, CURRENTLY SCHEDULED FOR NOVEMBER 8, 2022 FOR THE OFFICE OF DISTRICT COUNCIL AT-LARGE

- Writ, prepared by presiding officer, served on the Philadelphia County Board of Elections – September 15, 2022
- First day for political parties and minor political parties to nominate candidates by filing nomination certificates – September 15, 2022
- First day for political bodies to circulate and file nomination papers nominating candidates – September 15, 2022
- Last day to file nomination certificates and nomination papers – September 30, 2022
- Last day to file objections to nomination certificates and nomination papers – October 3, 2022
- Last day for the Court of Common Pleas to set a hearing on objections – October 7, 2022
- Last day for candidate withdrawal – October 7, 2022
- Last day to file substituted nomination certificates – October 7, 2022
- Last day to file objections to substituted nominations – 3 days after substituted nomination certificate is filed
- Last day to register to vote before the election – October 24, 2022
- Last day before the election on which official applications for civilian absentee and mail-in ballots may be received by the County Board of Elections – November 1, 2022
- All civilian absentee and mail-in ballots must be received by the County Board of Elections no later than 8:00 P.M. on this day to be counted – November 8, 2022
- Last day for the County Board of Elections to receive voted military and overseas absentee ballots – November 15, 2022

CAMPAIGN FINANCE REPORTING DEADLINES

- 2nd Friday Pre-Election – complete up to and including October 24, 2022 – Must be filed by October 28, 2022
- 24-Hour Reporting – Begins October 25, 2022, running through November 8, 2022
- 30 Day Post-Election – complete up to and including November 18, 2022 – Must be filed by December 8, 2022
