The candidate receiving the highest number of votes becomes the Majority Inspector, while the candidate with the second-highest number becomes the Minority Inspector. 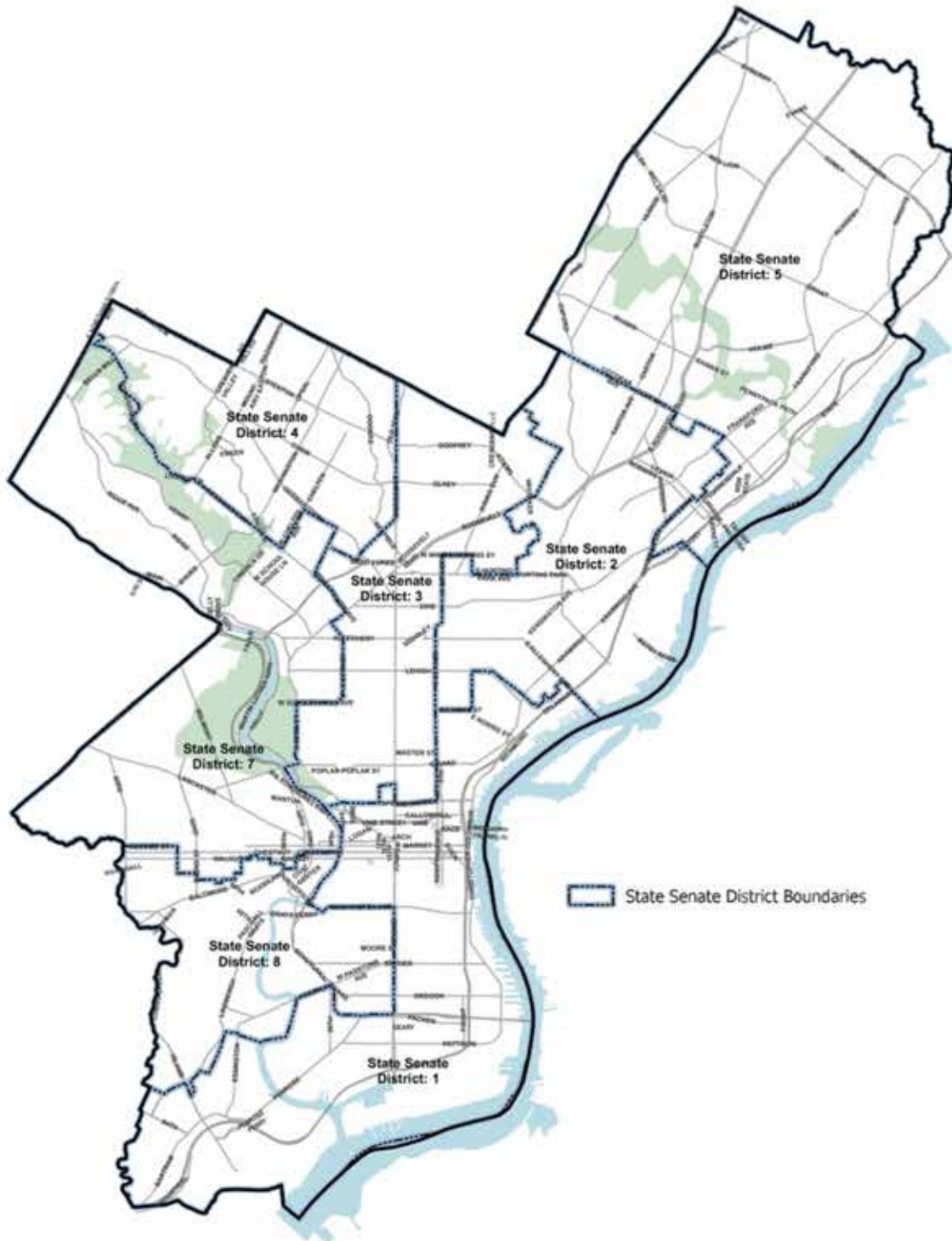

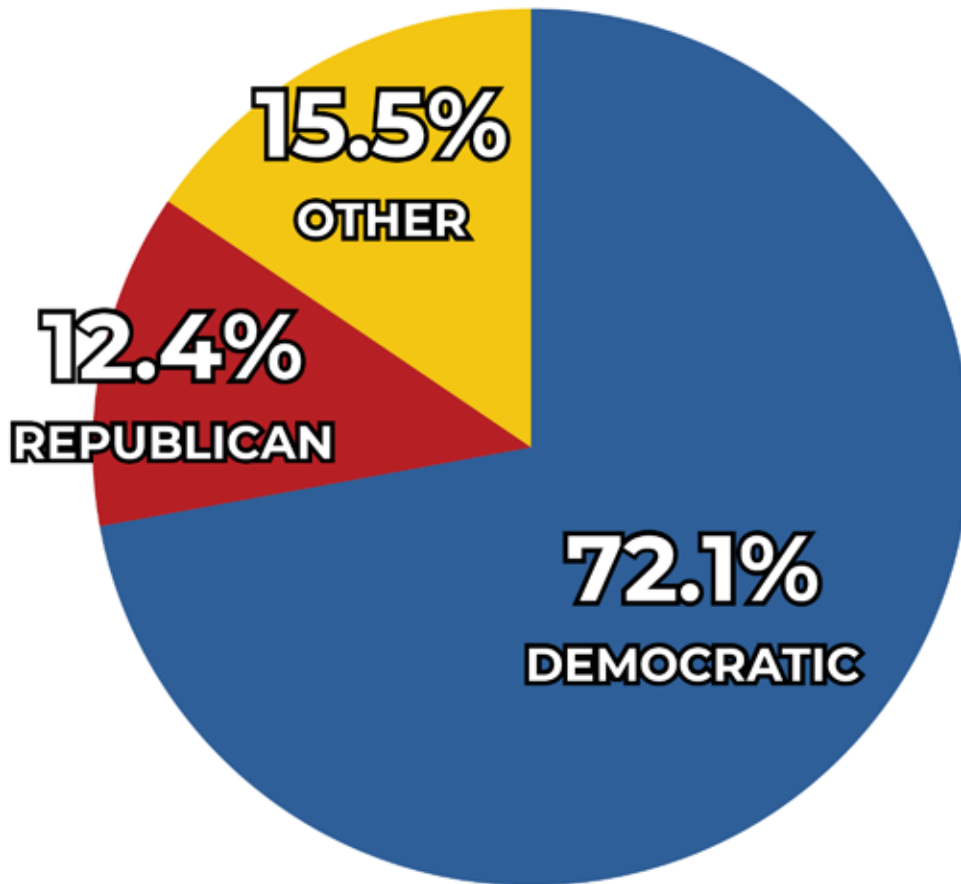

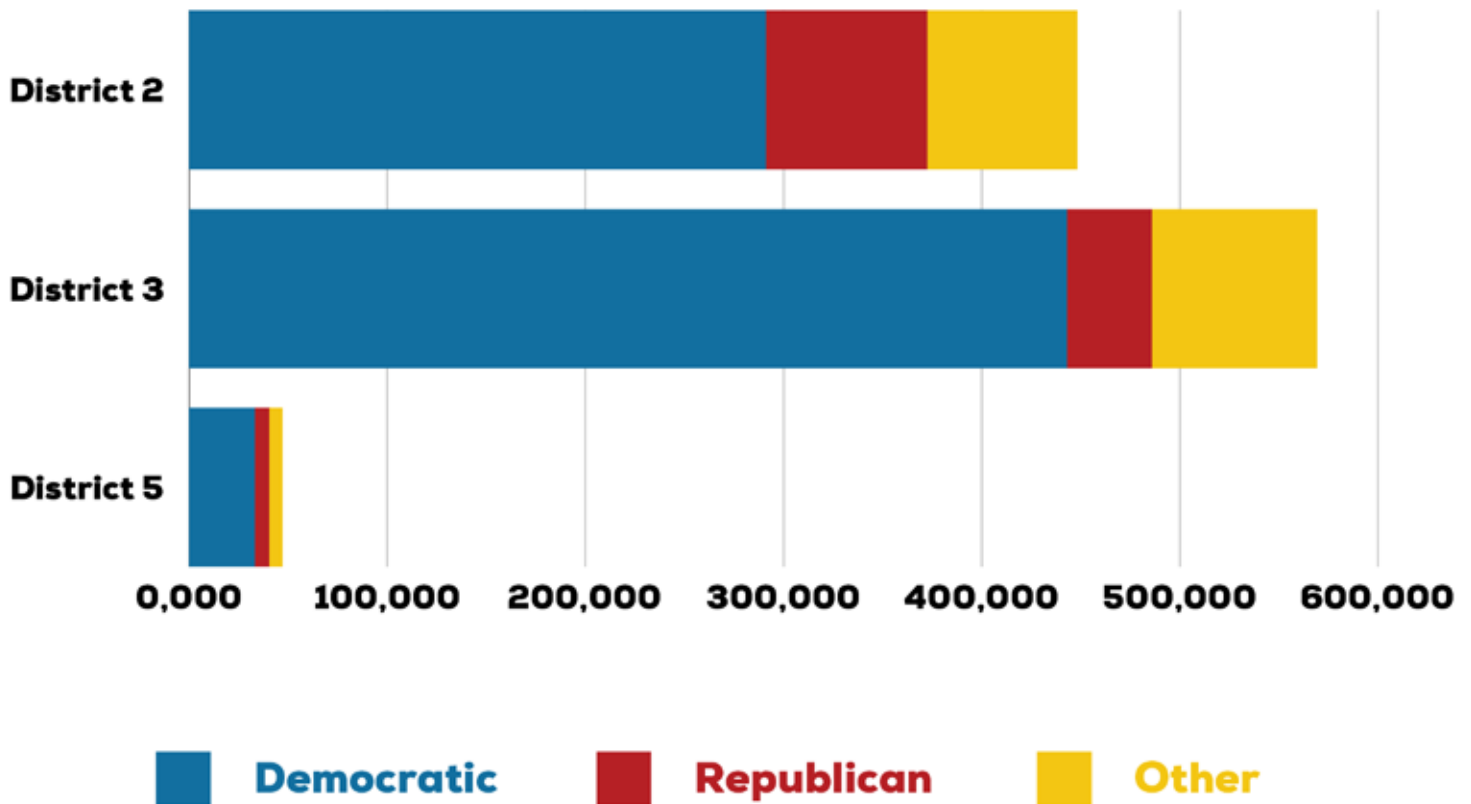

BY CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT

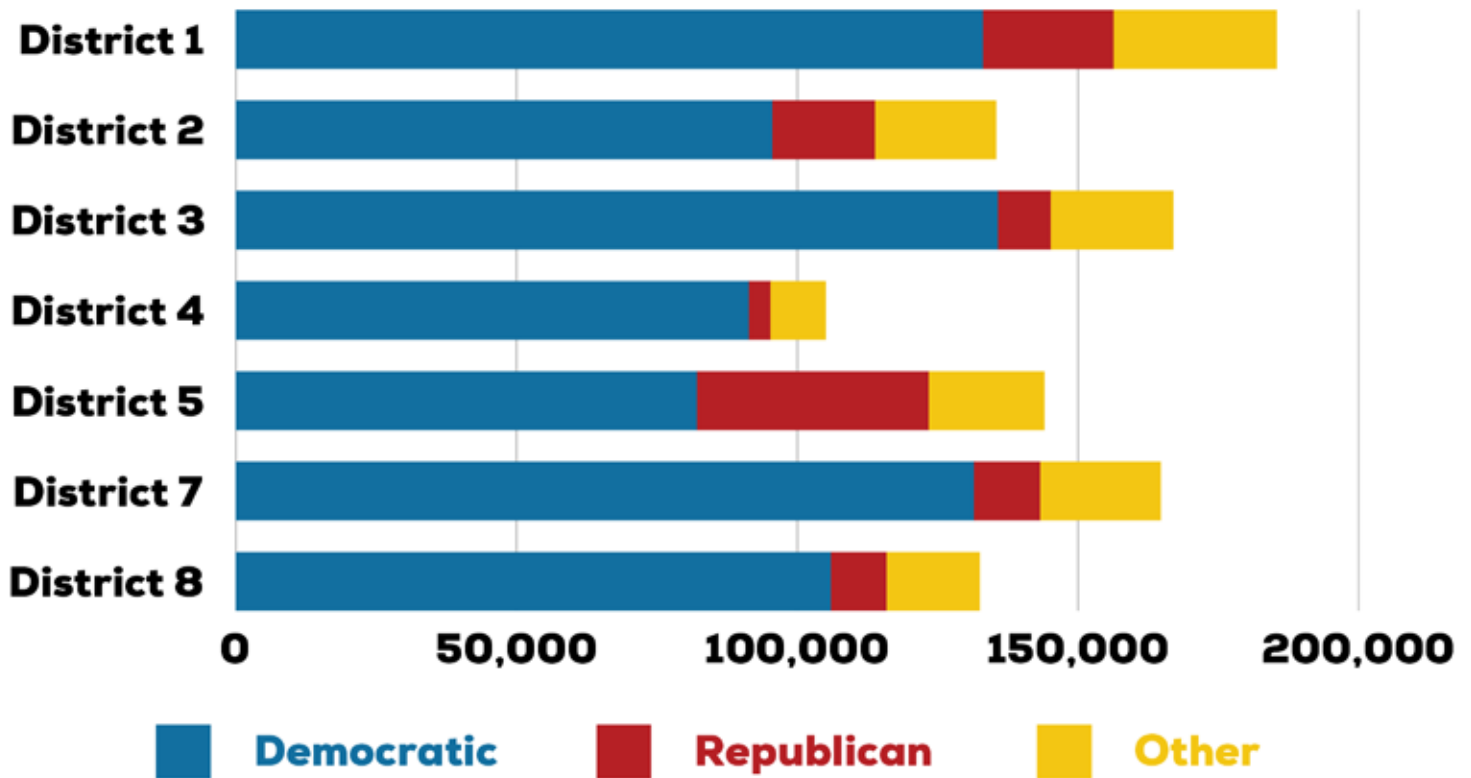

BY SENATORIAL DISTRICT

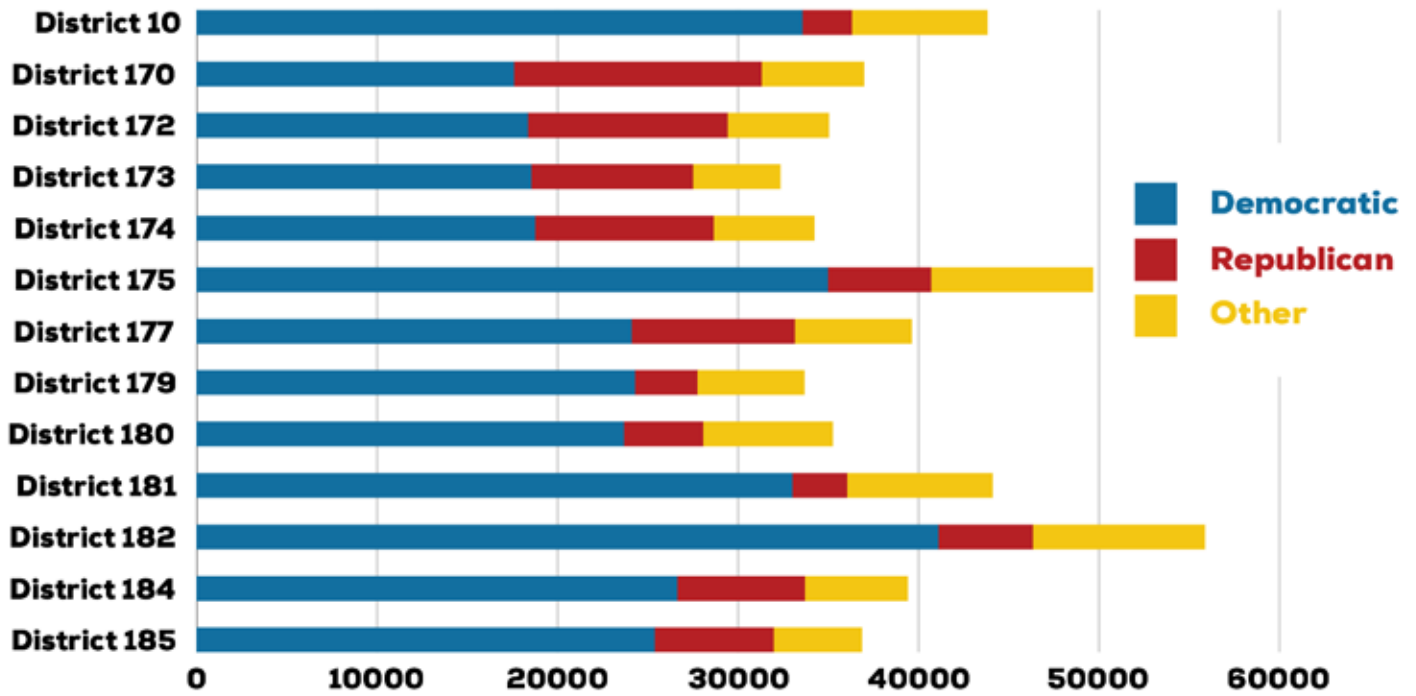

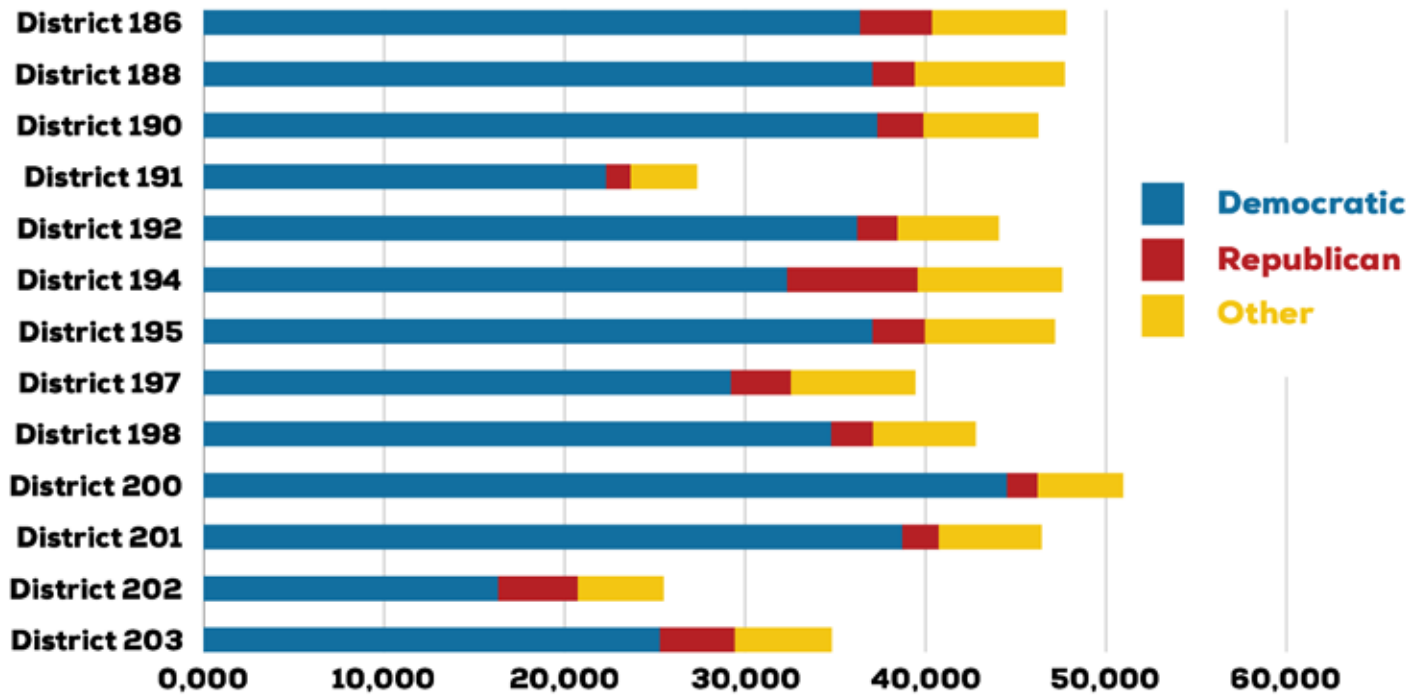

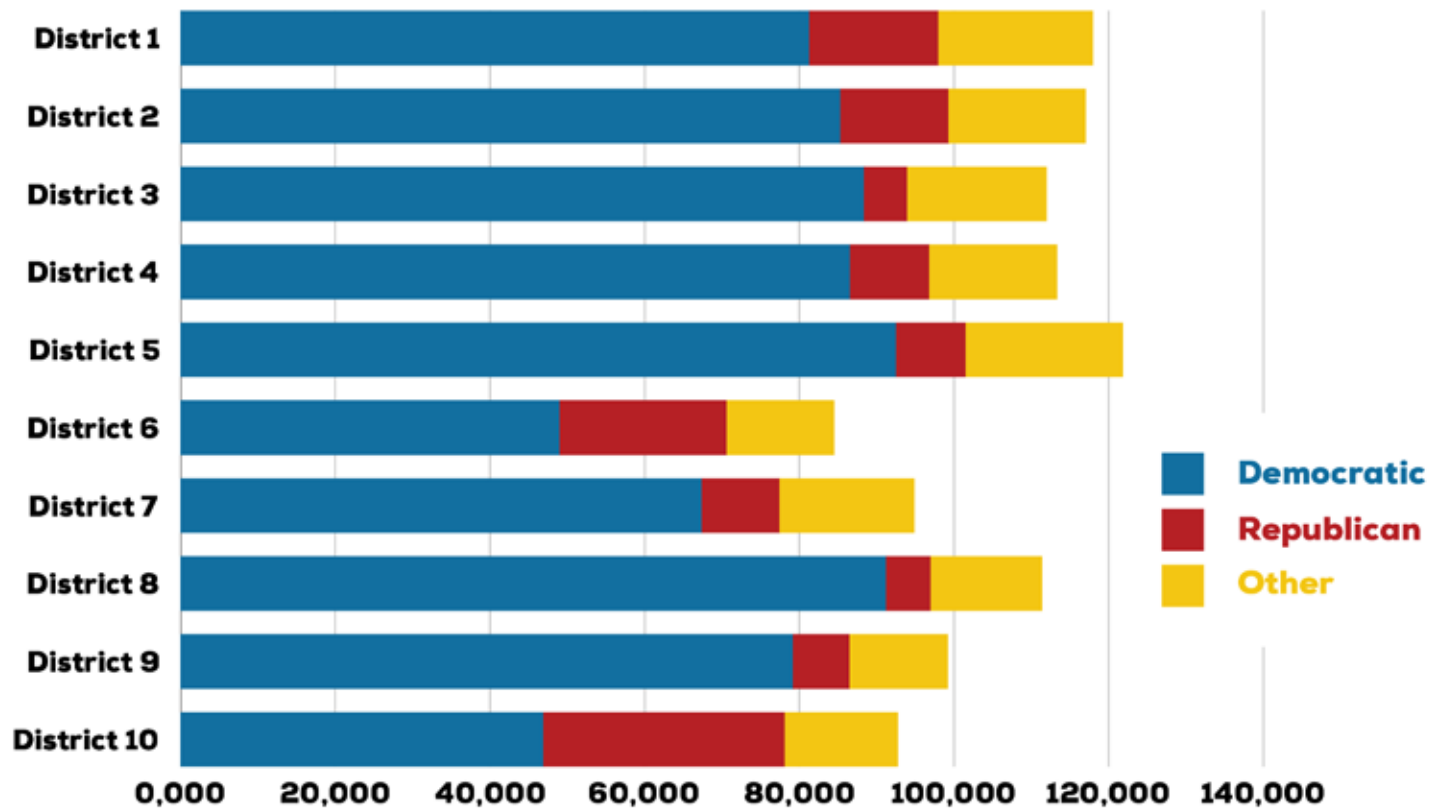

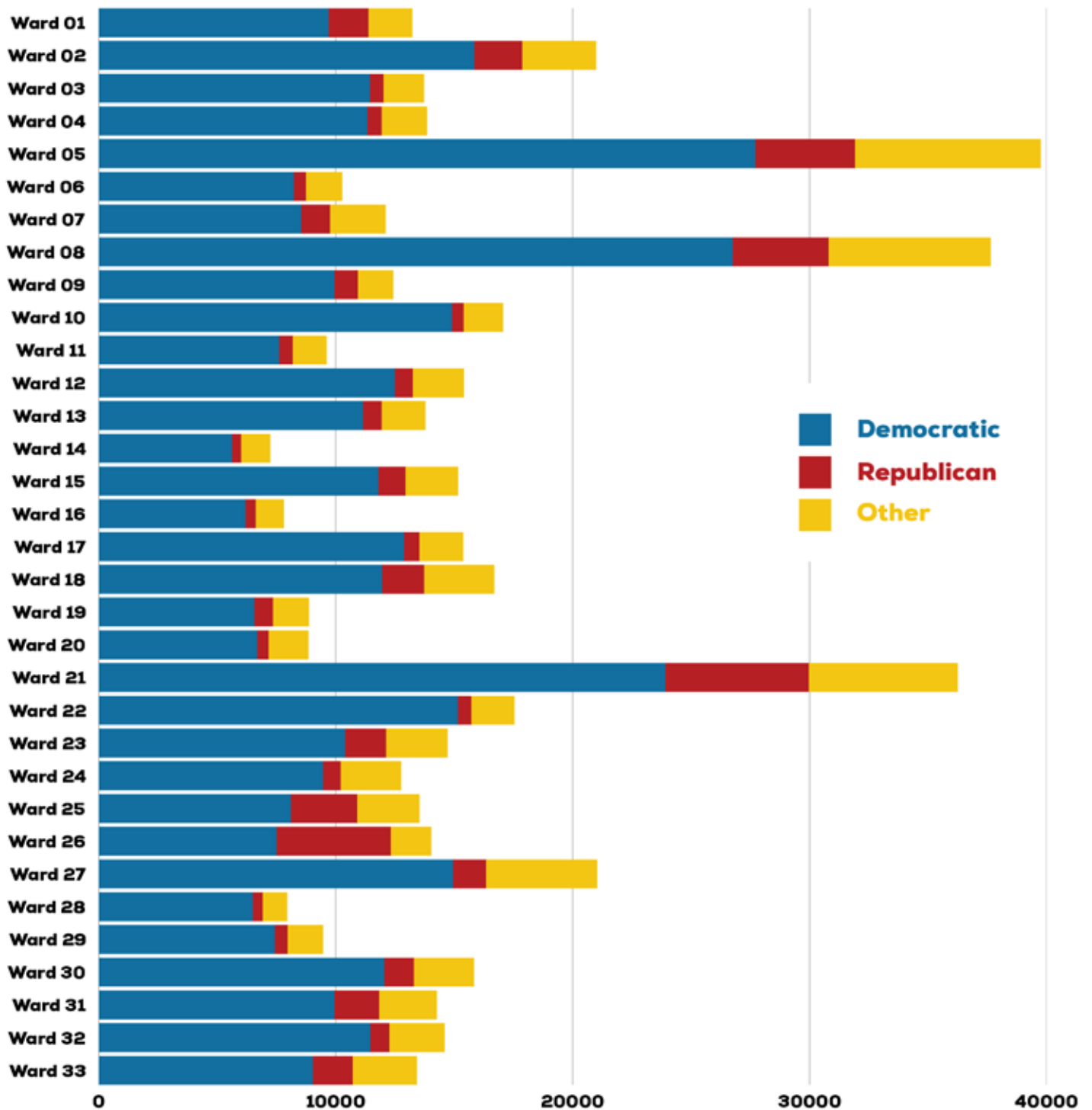

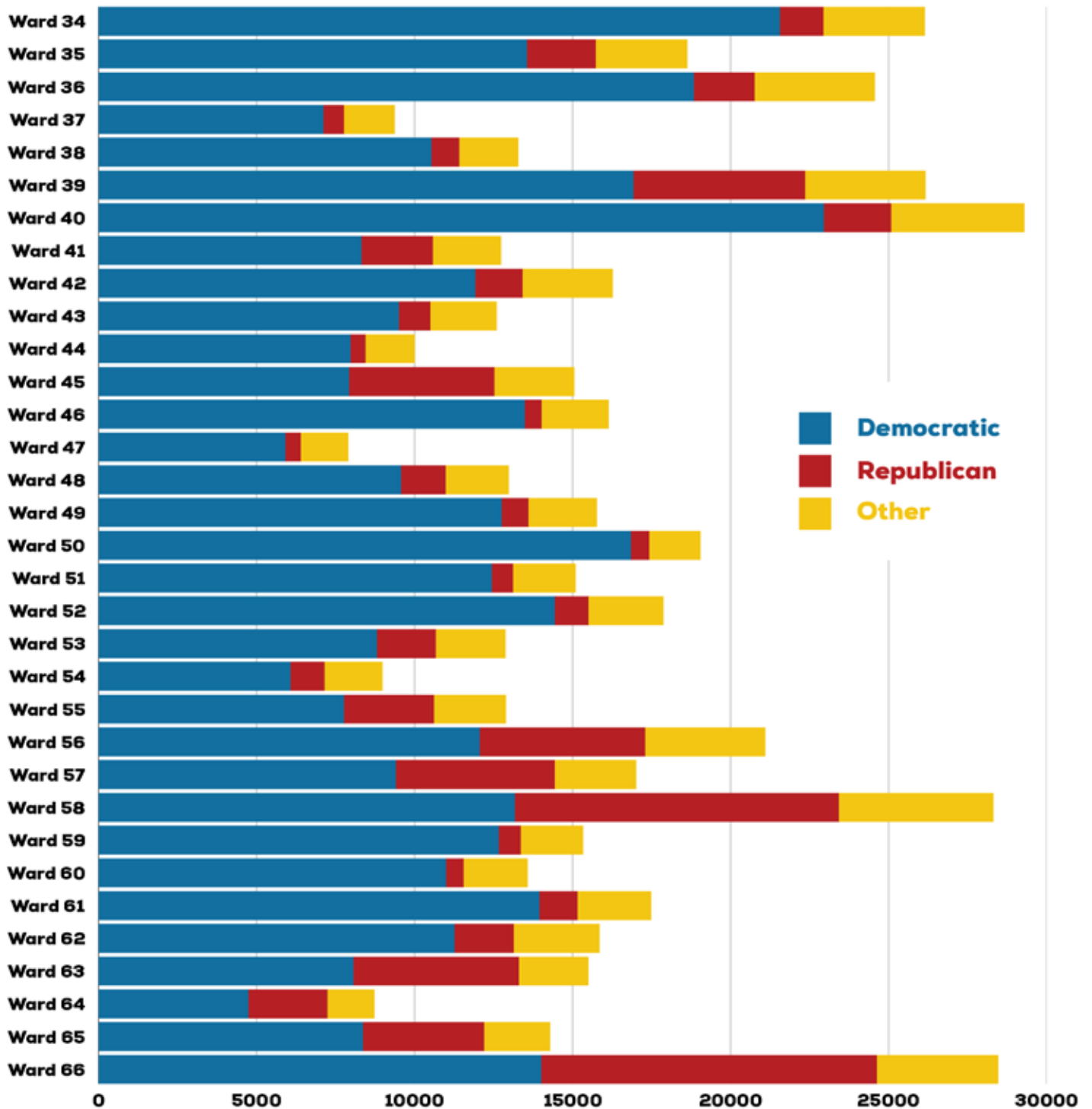

Voting in Philadelphia

TO REGISTER TO VOTE IN PHILADELPHIA, YOU MUST BE:

- A citizen of the United States for at least one month before the next election.
- A resident of Philadelphia and your election district for at least 30 days before the next election.
- At least 18 years of age on or before the day of the next election.

Primary Elections: All registered electors are entitled to vote on ballot questions or in special elections held at the same time as primary elections. However, **you must be registered in a political party** to vote in that party's primary.

Special Elections: Pennsylvania holds special elections when someone in office can no longer serve. This may happen when someone resigns, dies, or gets removed from office. Voters must select someone to replace that person. Every registered voter in the district the candidates will represent can vote in the special election.

REGISTERING TO VOTE:

You can register to vote online, by mail, or at several government agencies, including PennDOT Photo License and Driver's License Centers.

By Mail: A voter registration application can be obtained by contacting the Voter Registration Unit at 215-686-1590, or downloading and printing the voter registration application available at <https://vote.phila.gov>

Online: Individuals can register to vote through the Pennsylvania Department of State's online application available at <https://vote.pa.gov>

Mail Voting

In Pennsylvania, you have two options for vote-by-mail ballots:

- **Absentee ballot** – If you plan to be out of the municipality on election day or if you have a disability or illness, you should request an absentee ballot, which still requires you to list a reason for your ballot.
- **Mail-in ballot** – All registered voters may apply for a mail-in ballot without needing to provide a reason. You may simply request this ballot.

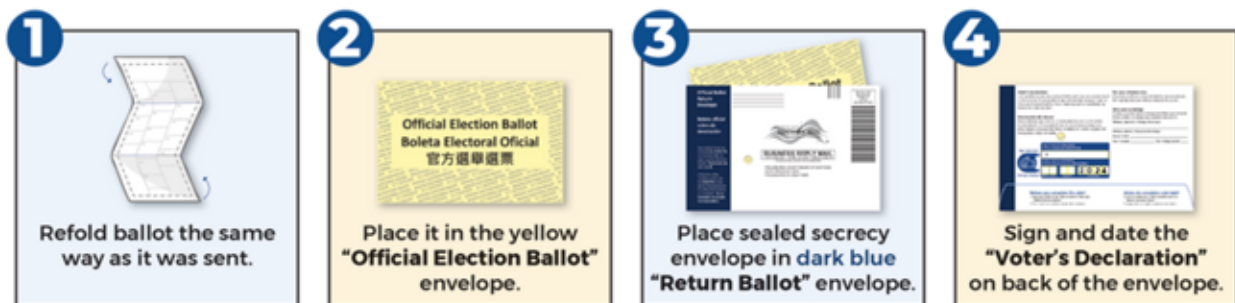
In order to request a mail ballot, you must be registered to vote.

You can request a mail-in or absentee ballot online at <https://vote.pa.gov>, OR you can also request to have an application mailed to you. Contact the **Philadelphia County Board of Elections at (215) 686-3469** to request an application. You can also contact any of the three City Commissioners' Offices.

You can also download and print an absentee or mail-in ballot application from <https://vote.pa.gov>, fill out the form, and mail it to the Philadelphia County Board of Elections.

Once approved, the Philadelphia County Board of Elections will mail you your ballot along with instructions when ballots are available. You can check its status by going to <https://vote.pa.gov> or by contacting the **Philadelphia County Board of Elections at (215) 686-3469**.

WHEN RETURNING YOUR MAIL BALLOT, PLEASE BE SURE TO FOLLOW ALL INSTRUCTIONS, OR YOUR BALLOT MAY NOT COUNT.



You should mail your ballot as promptly as possible, or personally deliver it to the County Board of Elections office, Satellite Election Office, or drop box no later than 8:00 p.m. on Election Day.
