This is an official notice of a General Primary and Special Election to be conducted on 4/23/2024 in all Election Districts within Philadelphia County. You may register to vote and request an official absentee ballot by using the Federal Postcard Application (FPCA), available at [www.votespa.com](http://www.votespa.com), [www.fvap.gov](http://www.fvap.gov) or download here: [Download Fillable FPCA](#) \*

This application is acceptable for General, Primary, and Special elections for which you are eligible in that calendar year alone. We recommend you send in a new FPCA every January and each time you move.

You may apply for an absentee ballot by submitting your FPCA by fax to (215) 686-3398, or by email to [phillyelection@phila.gov](mailto:phillyelection@phila.gov). You may request an absentee ballot from this office at any time prior to a primary or general election.

All voted Military and Civilian Overseas Absentee Ballots must be **mailed back**, along with the voter's declaration, no later than 11:59 pm on the day before the election **and must be received** by the County Board of Elections no later than the Tuesday following the election.

If time does not permit you to receive and return an official absentee ballot and you have **already applied** for an absentee ballot, you are also entitled to vote using the Federal Write-in Absentee Ballot (FWAB). Military electors may also use the FWAB to register to vote and vote simultaneously.

You may use the FWAB to vote for **ALL** state and local offices, and ballot initiatives.

To vote for state and local offices or for ballot initiatives, write the names of candidates or ballot initiatives in the Addendum section of the FWAB. Under the **Office/Ballot Initiative** heading, enter the office the candidate is running for or the title of the Ballot Initiative (referendum). Under the **Candidate Name, Party Affiliation, or Initiative Vote** heading, list the name of the candidate you wish to vote for, or if you are voting on a Referendum question write "yes" or "no."

Todas las boletas para electores ausentes en actividad militar y civiles en el exterior en las que se haya emitido un voto deben **enviarse por correo postal**, junto con la declaración del votante, hasta las 11:59 p. m. del día antes de la elección **y debe recibirlas** la Junta Electoral del Condado hasta el martes posterior a la elección, como máximo.

Si el tiempo no le permite recibir y volver a enviar una boleta oficial para elector ausente y **ya ha solicitado** su boleta para elector ausente, tiene derecho a votar también con la Boleta federal para elector ausente autorizado (FWAB). Los electores en actividad militar también pueden usar la FWAB para registrarse para votar y votar en simultáneo.

Puede usar la FWAB para votar por **TODOS** los puestos estatales y locales, e iniciativas de votos.

Para votar por todos los puestos estatales y locales, o iniciativas de boletas, escriba los nombres de los candidatos o iniciativas de votos en la sección Anexo de la FWAB. Bajo el encabezado **Puesto/Iniciativa de voto**, ingrese el puesto para el que se postula el candidato o el título de la Iniciativa de voto (referéndum). Bajo el encabezado **Nombre del candidato, Afiliación política o Voto de iniciativa** mencione el nombre del candidato por el cual quiere votar, o bien, si vota por una pregunta de un referéndum, escriba "Sí" o "No".

## Question #1

### Proposed Charter Change 1

Submitted to the Voters By:

Bill No. 230740 (became law December 14, 2023);

Resolution No. 230750 (adopted November 30, 2023)

#### Ballot Question:

Should the Philadelphia Home Rule Charter be amended to require the City to provide for the indemnification and defense of registered community organizations in connection with claims made against them arising directly out of their lawful participation in the City's zoning variance process?

#### Statement:

Rules about how land and buildings can be used and built are called zoning. Registered community organizations, or "RCOs," are community groups that provide input on how those zoning rules are applied in their communities. For example, RCOs provide input when a landowner requests an exception from standard zoning rules, called a variance. Sometimes lawsuits are brought against RCOs related to their participation in the variance request process, which can be costly and limit community input.

If you vote "yes" on this ballot question, that means you approve of requiring the City to devise a system to help RCOs pay for the costs of defending against such lawsuits, which may include the costs associated with losing or settling the lawsuits.

Pregunta de la boleta electoral:

¿Debería modificarse la Carta de Autonomía de Filadelfia para exigir al ayuntamiento que indemnice y defienda a las Organizaciones comunitarias registradas (RCOs, por sus siglas en inglés) en relación con las demandas presentadas contra ellas que se deriven directamente de su participación legal en el proceso de variación de la zonificación del Ayuntamiento?

Declaración:

Las normas sobre el uso y la construcción de terrenos y edificios se denominan zonificación. Las Organizaciones comunitarias registradas (RCOs, por sus siglas en inglés) son grupos comunitarios que aportan su opinión sobre cómo se aplican esas normas de zonificación en sus comunidades. Por ejemplo, las RCOs realizan aportaciones cuando un propietario solicita una excepción a las normas de zonificación estándar, lo que se denomina una variación. A veces se interponen demandas contra las RCOs relacionadas con su participación en el proceso de solicitud de variaciones, lo que puede resultar costoso y limitar la aportación de la comunidad.

Si vota "sí" en esta pregunta de la boleta electoral, significa que aprueba que se exija a la ciudad que diseñe un sistema para ayudar a las RCOs a pagar los costos de defensa contra tales demandas, que pueden incluir los costos asociados a la pérdida o resolución de las demandas.

區域規劃（zoning）是指關於如何使用土地和建築物及建造方式的規定。註冊社區組織（或稱「RCOs」）是針對如何在其社區內應用這些區域規劃規定而提供意見的社區團體。例如，當土地所有者申請對標準區域規劃規定進行例外處理時，稱為「變更」（variance），註冊社區組織會對此提供相關意見。有時，註冊社區組織會因他們參與變更申請的過程而被提出訴訟，這可能會造成昂貴的訴訟費用，並限制社區提供意見。
